Fleetwood Mac have sold more than 120 million records worldwide, making them one of the world's best-selling bands. The iconic British-American rock band went through a revival when Lindsey Buckingham and Stevie Nicks joined Fleetwood Mac, giving the band a more pop-rock sound. Their 1975 album, *Rumours*, produced four U.S. top 10 singles and remained at number one on the chart for 31 weeks. It also won a Grammy® Award for *Album of the Year* in 1978. In 1979, the group was honored with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, and in 1998, they were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. *Rumours* has sold more than 40 million copies worldwide, making it one of the best-selling albums in history.

Channeling the spirit of Fleetwood Mac at their very best, Rumours of Fleetwood Mac offers a unique opportunity for fans, both old and new, to rediscover the songs and performances that have ensured Fleetwood Mac's place as one of the most loved groups of all time. The band has been praised by critics and fans alike for their ability to capture the spirit of Fleetwood Mac's music and to transport audiences back to the heyday of the band's career. Rumours of Fleetwood Mac consists of a group of musicians who hold Fleetwood Mac very close to their hearts and who endeavor to perform their music as authentically as possible: Allan Cosgrove, Jess Harwood, Emily Gervers, James Harrison, Scott Poley, Etienne Girard, and Dave Goldberg.
