DOs and DON'Ts

DO refer to Broadway shows as being presented by Ensemble Arts Philly.



"Ensemble Arts Philly presents Wicked at the Academy of Music."

DO NOT refer to The Philadelphia Orchestra as presenting shows under the Ensemble Arts Philly brand.



"The Philadelphia Orchestra and Ensemble Arts present comedian John Mulaney."

DO say:



"Ensemble Arts Philly presents comedian John Mulaney."

DO NOT refer to Ensemble Arts Philly for Philadelphia Orchestra performances.



"Music and Artistic Director Yannick Nézet-Séguin and The Philadelphia Orchestra will perform Mahler's Symphony No. 3 in Marian Anderson Hall at the Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts, brought to you by The Philadelphia Orchestra and Ensemble Arts."

DO say:



"Music and Artistic Director Yannick Nézet-Séguin and The Philadelphia Orchestra will perform Mahler's Symphony No. 3 in Marian Anderson Hall at the Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts."

DO refer to our education and community programs as part of Ensemble Arts Philly unless it is a specific Philadelphia Orchestra education program:



"The free classical music education program for third graders was made possible thanks to The Philadelphia Orchestra and Ensemble Arts."



"The theater camp for students was presented by Ensemble Arts Philly."

DO say the Ensemble Arts Philly presentation is happening at the Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts, Academy of Music, Miller Theater, or Forrest Theatre.



"Ensemble Arts Philly presents John Mulaney at the Miller Theater."

DO NOT say the performance is happening at Ensemble Arts Philly.
