## Receivers

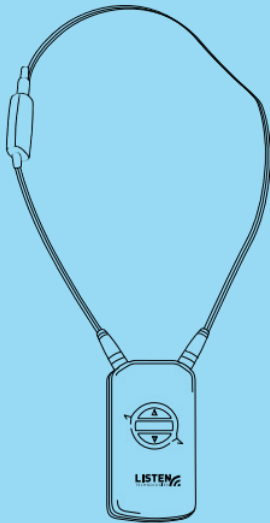


### Marian Anderson Hall and Perelman Theater

- Power on by simply pressing the top power button.
- To protect hearing, at power up, receiver will reset to a 25% volume. Volume adjusts with up and down buttons.
- Channels are automatically set and ready to go
- Each ALD has a label to distinguish which venue
- 2 guests can share a receiver with two inputs

### Commonwealth Plaza, Rendell Room & Hamilton Garden (Older ALD Model):

- AA Battery powered w/ power by volume switch
- Incompatible w/ T-Coil hearing aids. Headphones only.



## T-Loops

The Ear Phone/Neck Loop Lanyard can be used by guests who have T-coil enabled hearing aids or cochlear implants, inducing audio directly into T-coil enabled devices. Guests can simply plug both ends of the Loop Lanyard into the receiver and wear as a necklace. Additional headphones can also plug into the Loop Lanyard if needed.
