

6-Week Playwriting Course

Work with playwright Ali Taylor, whose previous works have played to great acclaim at the Soho and Hampstead Theatres. Writers will be introduced to the skills necessary for writing a play, by engaging in practical exercises. The workshops will also provide insight into creating characters, writing dialogue and structuring scenes. As well as sharing work, writers will study new playscripts as well as some classic texts. The course will culminate in the writers presenting their work in the form of a rehearsed reading with professional actors, on stage in one of our West End Theatres in front of an invited audience.

Performance Course

Work with a West End Director and MD, devising your own unique piece of theatre. Hone performance skills and learn what it is to be a member of a Theatre company, culminating in a one off performance on a West End stage. For 2017, we are offering one participant of the course the very exciting chance to win a walk on part in a professional show!

Schools workshops

Our West End Creative Learning team offer bespoke workshops across London's West End designed to support you delivering curriculum centred learning. Our workshops can be show specific, or about a theme, skill/technique or discipline, or designed to support any curriculum challenges you may be facing.

Our workshops can be run within your school, within one of our West End theatres, or in one of our rehearsal spaces in the West End. We have a flat rate fee for all our schools workshops of £7.00 per hour per participants.



Outreach projects

Our West End Creative Learning team invest in a series of outreach initiatives from funded places on any of our courses, discounted tickets schemes to projects involving external funding. For the last two years we have been lucky enough to work with a group of young 14-16 year olds in Hackney, where they collaborated with a Director and an MD, for a series of weeks, on their very own piece of theatre, performing it on a West End stage. By doing this we are giving youngsters the opportunity to be creative, discover new skills and believe in themselves. We are pleased to announce that we have a new exciting project to be rolled out for 2017.

Having been alarmed at the rise of news stories where girls and young women are being pressurised to act a certain way on social media, our West End Creative Learning team have commissioned a piece of research, working hand in hand with schools which we hope will culminate in the creation of a piece of verbatim theatre, focussing on developing self-respect and a new way of thinking.
