This is what my ticket will look like



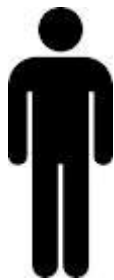
It tells me where I will be sitting

Disabled Toilet

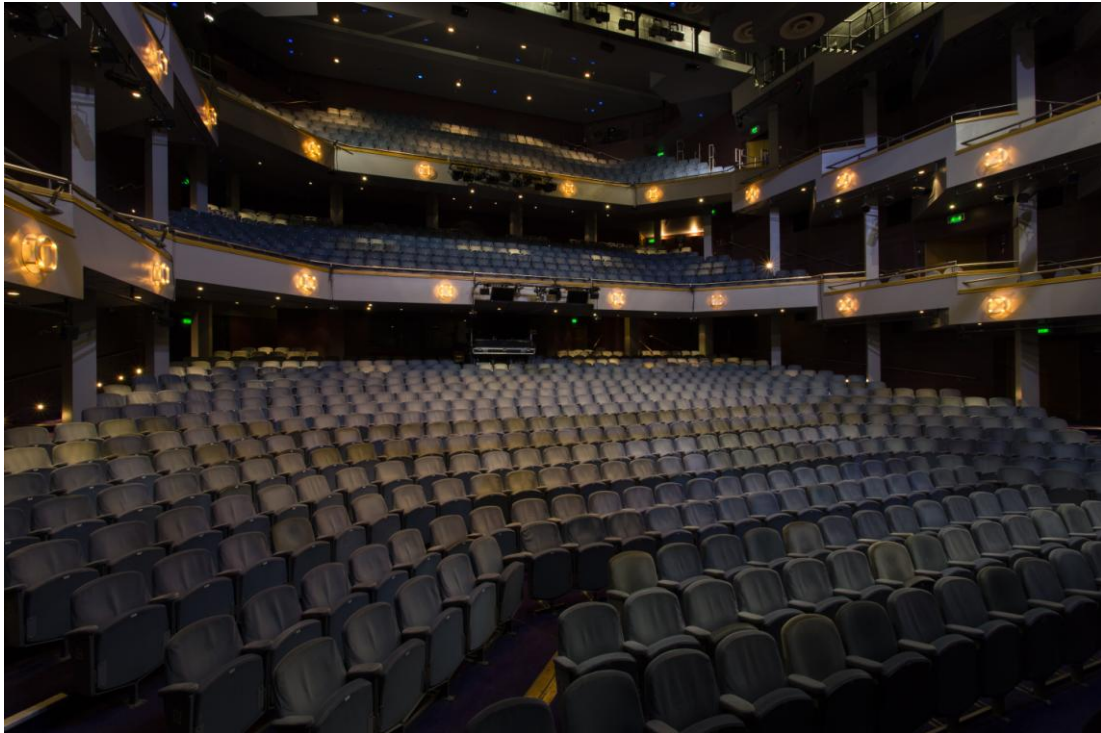
I can go to one of the bars before the show and have a drink if I would like to



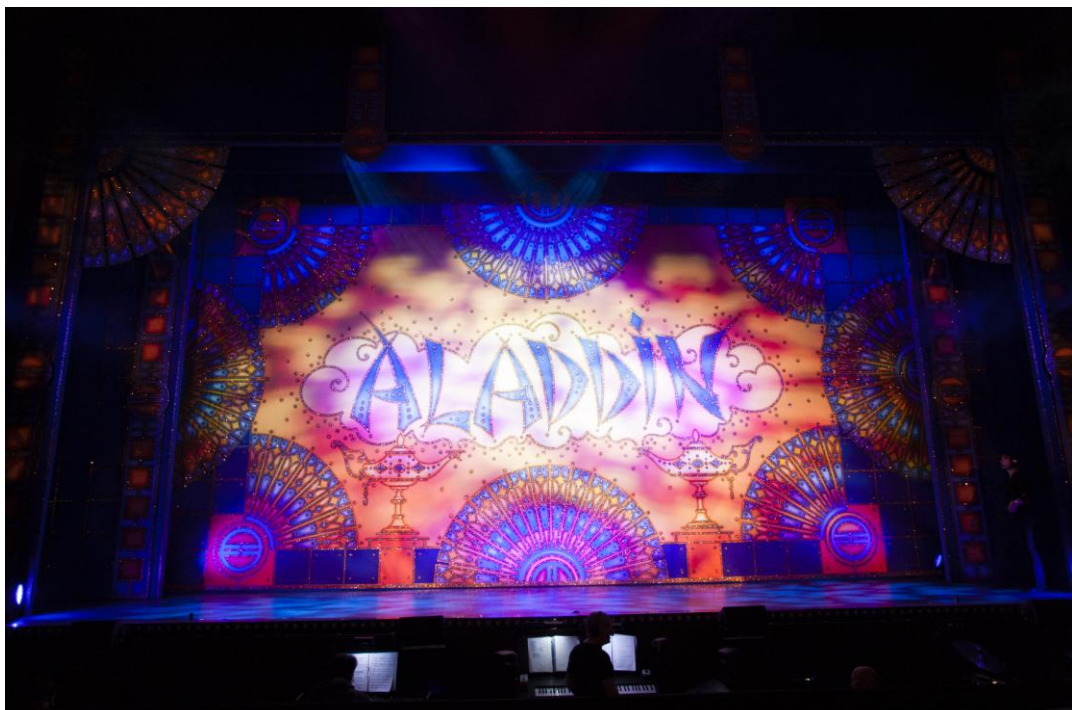
When I go into the auditorium I will show my ticket to an usher



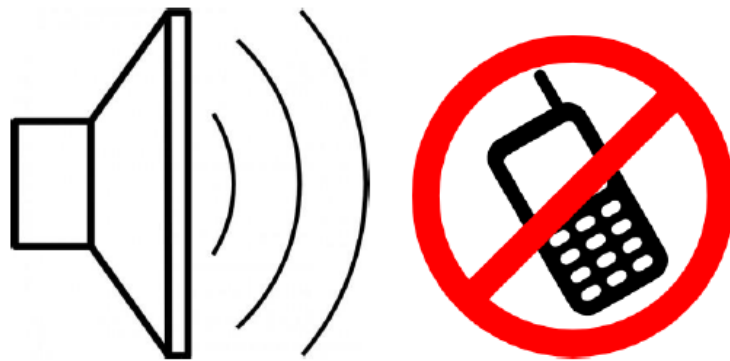
My seat will be somewhere in the auditorium that looks like this:

When the show is about to start I will hear an announcement telling everyone with a mobile phone to turn them off.



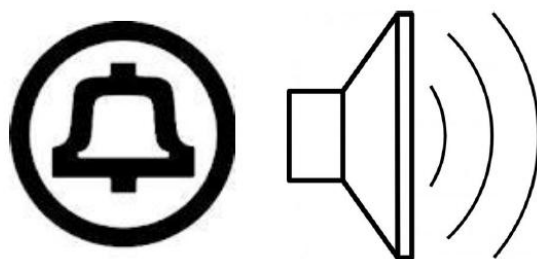
The Theatre will get dark and everyone will be quiet. It is important to try to be quiet during the show so I can hear everything that is going on

If I want to I can cover my ears if I think the performance is too loud. I can also wear my headphones, or ask an Usher to show me to the chill out zone.



There is a break in the middle of the show called an interval. The show will stop for 20 minutes and the lights in the auditorium will come on. I can get up and go buy a drink or an ice cream if I like.

At the end of the interval, I will hear an announcement asking everyone to go back to their seats as the show is about to start again. If I'm not already sitting down, I will go back to my seat and try to sit quietly.



At the end of the show people will clap to show their appreciation for the actors. I can clap too if I want to. The clapping might seem loud and scary, so I can cover my ears if I want to, but I know that people are only making a noise because they are happy.
