

West End Performers

From aspiring west end performers to those who want to gain more confidence in performing, this workshop puts actors and performers front and centre. Led in a rehearsal room style by West End practitioners, participants will engage in practical exercises to unlock students potential.

After a professional warm ups students will work towards honing in their skills, building characters, presence and ensemble techniques. This workshop is designed to ignite participant's imaginations whilst building confidence in their own performance ability.

West End Voice

Take your students on an exploration of the key skills needed to rehearse and perform in a musical. The workshop explores exercises that help students move from acting into song and movement and how to create truthful characters within a musical setting. The workshop equips students with the skills to bring a musical to life.

West End Text Exploration

Ever picked up a script and not sure where to start? How do we unpick in a rehearsal room the hidden possibilities within the text? Led by actors and directors, this workshop is designed for those interested in text based performance. From actions and objectives, to proxemics and language, this workshop will take participants step by step through the challenges of getting the most out of script work as performers.

West End Physicality and Movement

These workshops are specifically designed to give participants an insight into creating their own work and using their bodies to create performance. With more and more West End workshops embracing physicality and movement, get ready to create, explore and move!

These workshops are practical led and will introduce participants to the basics of movement based performance, using their bodies to unpick what their ideas of what theatre and performance can be, whilst building skills in this high energy workshop.

Devising

What is devising and where do you start? In this workshop, students will develop, create and explore devised theatre and practitioners will equip pupils with the knowledge and understanding of how to begin creating their own pieces of theatre.

Skilled facilitators will share their distinctive creative processes, facilitating experimentation to create theatre, where students experience how a professional artists and theatre makers create new material, equipping participants with a toolkit of skills to take away and use in their own devising work.
