

ROLLER DISCO FAQ's

Are there any age restrictions for the Roller Disco?

Our daytime roller discos are family friendly and suitable for all ages from 4 upwards, but all under 16's must have an adult present. Our evening events are suitable for over 18's only.

Can you drink alcoholic drinks at the Roller Disco?

We will be serving a selection of alcoholic drinks at our evening events. We have a seating area with a bar and food options. No alcoholic drinks are allowed on the skate floor. We may ask patrons to remove their skates if they are no longer able to skate safely.

Do I have to be able to skate before I can come?

You don't need to be able to skate before attending.

Can I bring my own skates?

Yes, you can bring your own roller or inline skates to the Roller Disco, but you must ensure they are in a maintained and safe working condition, with non-marking toe stops. Skates that the venue provides have all been carefully serviced and checked.

Will there be stewards?

We have stewards on hand who are not wearing skates and are available to assist if needed. We will also provide free wrist guards, elbow and knee pads and helmets.

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What music will be playing?

Music to make you want to dance! 70's, 80's and 90's disco classics.

What do I have to wear?

Wear whatever makes you feel comfortable, but we do encourage joining in on the fun and throwing on some disco glam!

Where can I store my belongings?

It's best not to take too much onto the rink, however you can leave your belongings with any non-skater friends in the bar area.

Is there food and drink?

We have a bar available where we serve a wide range of soft drinks, snacks and a special selection of alcoholic drinks for evening events.

Can I attend but not skate?

Yes, not a problem! We have a slightly cheaper non-skate ticket, allowing you to sit at the bar and watch your family and friends as they skate.

What skate sizes do you have to rent?

Skate rentals start from a UK child's size 9, up to adults size 12.
