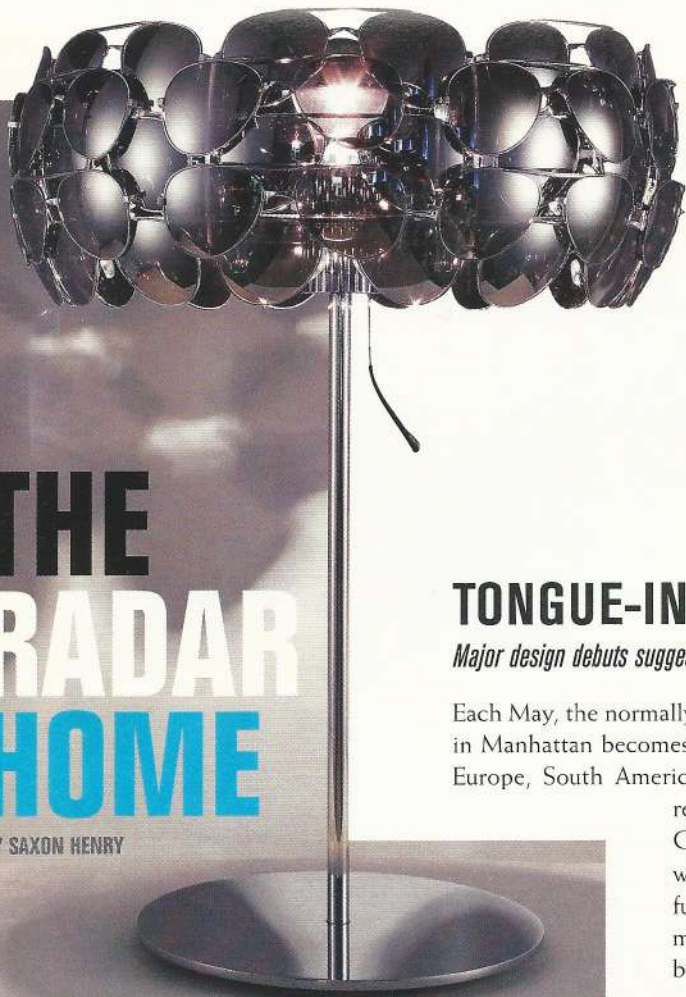


# THE RADAR HOME
