

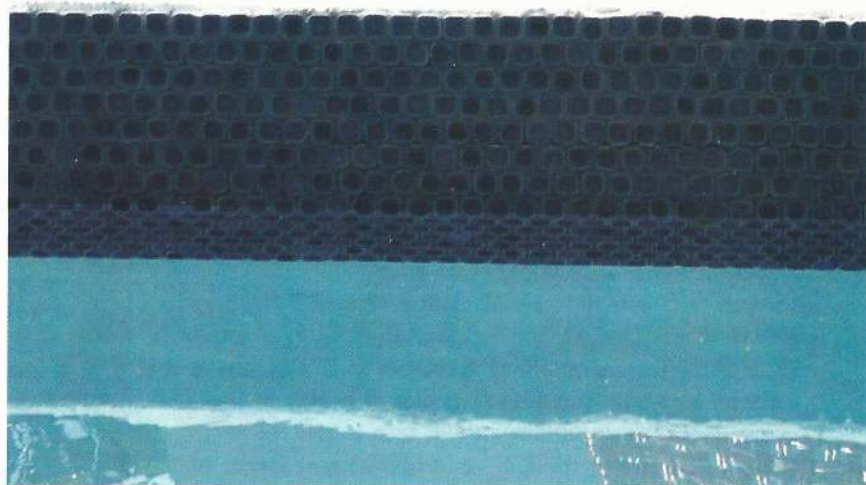

When Mira Lehr, a painter based in Miami Beach, wanted to have some landscaping done 11 years ago at her home on Pine Tree Drive, she turned for some advice to an expert, Dan Kiley. Known for his ultramodern landscape architecture, Kiley took on the project, which lasted nine months, all via phone and faxes. The Lehr residence still looks fresh, as do Kiley's concepts—paving stones interspersed with geometric patches of grass, free-standing concrete slabs and a bosque of royal palms. It was the perfect location for this year's pool and patio show house.

The teak table (\$2,547), from the Paola Navone collection from Gervasoni, has a ceramic base. The ceramic stools are from the same collection and cost \$217 a piece. In the palm tree bosque, ceramic bottles, also from Gervasoni, cost \$372 and \$566.
