

Falorna Teppa and Vair Marcoschamer were tapped by the design team to introduce interior floral and plant elements, and to implement the landscaping, "We brought a bit of the tropics indoors without affecting the clean modern feel of the home," Marcoschamer says of their strategy for the interiors. They worked with landscape designer Alex Rodriguez to envision the exterior gardens. "Instead of small gestures, we chose broad strokes with our plantings," Rodriguez explains, noting his rod toward the modernist-inspired design scheme and the couple's desire for a low-maintenance, verdant landscape.
