Disclaimer - Spirit of Belron Round the World Challenge - Virtual Event

If you intend to take part in the Virtual Spirit of Belron Round the World Challenge between Wednesday September 13th and Saturday September 23rd inclusive, you must read, understand and agree to the following statement and instructions before registering to take part.

If you are under the age of 18 a parent or guardian must agree to the following statement and instructions on your behalf.

References to "you" are to the relevant participant and to "we" or "us" are to Belron International Limited, the event host, and its employees, representatives, service providers and agents.

Participation in the event(s)

You undertake the Spirit of Belron Round the World Challenge (Virtual Event) (the "Challenge") voluntarily and at your own risk.

Athletes under the age of 13 are not permitted to register for the Challenge with our third party platform provider, Atlas Unlimited Inc. ("AtlasGO"), however, parents or guardians may upload details of events completed by athletes under the age of 13, provided that no personal information relating to the athlete is captured. This includes the name and age of the athlete.

For those of you that are under 18 years of age on the date you participate in the Challenge ("young athletes"), your and your guardian's attention is drawn in particular to those additional provisions below relating to young athletes.

Your health and fitness

You understand that your Challenge event may be physically strenuous, and you confirm that you are both healthy and fit enough to take part.

You understand that there are physical risks associated with the event and that it is your sole responsibility to assess the nature and extent of these risks before entering your event.

It is up to you to determine if you need to undertake a thorough physical examination from an appropriately qualified medical practitioner prior to undertaking a Challenge event. We strongly recommend in particular, if you or anyone in your family has a history of heart disease, hypertension, diabetes or any degenerative joint or muscular disease you should first obtain permission from an appropriately qualified medical practitioner prior to undertaking any Challenge event.

You agree that should any medical or physical condition arise prior to or during your Challenge event that affects or may affect your ability to safely take part in your event you will immediately withdraw.

In addition to the above, we would draw your attention to the following specific guidelines:

- You should not take part in a Challenge event after consuming alcohol.
- You should not take part in a Challenge event within two hours of eating a large meal.
- Please ensure that your clothing and footwear are suitable and properly fitting.
- Where possible avoid taking part in a Challenge event alone.
- Always warm up prior to exercise and cool down afterwards.

Important safety information for young athletes

Young athletes should only undertake activities that their guardians are happy for them to participate in and they should supervise them during these activities or arrange supervision from a professional organisation that they are happy with.

Media and photography

You understand and accept that any photographs and video footage that you may upload to the Spirit of Belron Round the World Challenge platform provided by AtlasGO or otherwise provide to us may be used by us for use to publicise and promote other events and sponsors in accordance with our usual retention policy.

Before uploading any photographs or video footage of other athletes, please ensure that you have their permission to do so. Please do not upload any photographs or video footage of athletes who are under the age of 13.

Exclusion of liability

You agree that we shall not be liable to you for any loss (including indirect or consequential loss) suffered by you or to your personal equipment arising as a result of you taking part in the Challenge, provided that nothing in this agreement shall affect any potential liability to you for death or personal injury, fraud, or any other liability to the extent such liability cannot be excluded or limited by law.

Data protection and privacy

Any personal information you have supplied us in connection with your registration for and participation in the Challenge has been collected by us or by a third-party supplier and will be processed in accordance with the provisions of our SOBC Privacy Notice, which you can read at SOBC Privacy Policy 2023.

Please note that all data you have uploaded to the AtlasGO platform relating to the Spirit of Belron Round the World Challenge will be deleted by AtlasGO on 30 November 2023 so please make sure you have copies of any data you wish to keep. We will retain copies of some photographs and videos as set out above.
