






#### **BEFORE INSTALLING YOUR FAUCET**

Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.

Image shown may vary from product purchased.


#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



- Apply a bead of putty to bottom edge of ESCUTCHEON with PUTTY PLATE (1).

  Make certain the SEAL (9) is properly seated in recess of faucet body. Insert SUPPLY HOSES (2), SPRAY HOSE (7) and SHANK (3) through hole of ESCUTCHEON with PUTTY PLATE (1) and mounting surface. Follow mounting instructions below to secure faucet to mounting surface.
- Insert HOSES (2) through RUBBER WASHER (4), BRASS WASHER (5), and threaded LOCKNUT (6).
- Assemble RUBBER WASHER (4), BRASS WASHER (5), and threaded LOCKNUT (6) onto SHANK (3) from underside of sink or mounting surface. Hand tighten LOCKNUT (6).
- Use a screwdriver to tighten SCREWS (8) on LOCKNUT (6). Work your way around LOCKNUT (6), tightening the screws slightly each time until all are snug to ensure even pressure.





- Discard ESCUTCHEON with PUTTY PLATE (1)
   Make certain the SEAL (9) is properly seated in
   recess of RING BASE (10). Insert supply
   HOSES (2), SPRAY HOSE (7) and SHANK (3)
   through mounting hole and seat RING BASE (10)
   onto sink or mounting surface. Do not use putty.
- Insert HOSES (2) through RUBBER WASHER (4), BRASS WASHER (5), and threaded LOCKNUT (6).
- Assemble RUBBER WASHER (4), BRASS WASHER (5), and threaded LOCKNUT (6) onto SHANK (3) from underside of sink or mounting surface. Hand tighten LOCKNUT (6).
- Use a screwdriver to tighten SCREWS (8) on LOCKNUT (6). Work your way around LOCKNUT (6), tightening the screws slightly each time until all are snug to ensure even pressure.





#### MAKE WATER SUPPLY CONNECTIONS




# Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.

- Connect FLEXIBLE SUPPLY HOSES (1, 2) directly to wall supplies. Connection on fitting supplies are 3/8" compression. Connect the supply hose with the red label to the Hot wall supply. Connect the supply hose with the blue label to the Cold wall supply. Use an adjustable wrench to tighten connections. Do not over tighten.
- \* Faucet supplies are 38" long from faucet base.
- Note: If additional supply length is required, installer must purchase additional parts separately.
- Important: If SUPPLY HOSES (1, 2) are too long, loop as illustrated to avoid kinking.






# CONNECT SPRAY HOSE



• Push the SPRAY HOSE END (2) into the HOSE CONNECTOR (1) slide down LOCKING COLLAR (3) until it snaps into place to secure connection.

4 INSTALL WEIGHT




• With SPRAY HEAD (4) seated in SPOUT (5), install WEIGHT (7) onto HOSE (6) 24 inches from the underside of the sink deck and secure with LATCH (8).

**NOTE:** there is a label on the hose indicating weight placement.

# 5 CHECK CONNECTIONS FOR LEAKS

- Move HANDLE into "off" position.
- Turn on water supplies and check connections for leaks.
- Operate HANDLE up and down, left and right to flush lines thoroughly.
- Operate SPRAY HEAD and check connections for leaks.





#### TEST INSTALLED FAUCET

- Move HANDLE (1) into "off" position.
- Turn on water supplies.
- With HANDLE (1) in "off" position, unthread SPRAY (3) from HOSE (2).
- Operate handle back to front, in COLD and HOT positions, to flush water lines thoroughly.
- Thread SPRAY HEAD (3) onto HOSE (2).


#### **SPRAY OPERATION**

- With faucet on press TOGGLE BUTTON (4) on SPRAY (3) to switch from stream to spray.
- Press and hold PAUSE BUTTON (5) to temporarily stop flow from SPRAY (3). Release PAUSE BUTTON (5) to resume flow from SPRAY (3).



#### **INSTALL SOAP DISPENSER**

- Insert SOAP DISPENSER SHANK (1) through O-RING (2) and the deck.
- Thread MOUNTING NUT (3) on to SOAP DISPENSER SHANK (1) to secure it to the deck.
- Fill SOAP BOTTLE (4) and thread it on to SOAP DISPENSER SHANK (1).

#### **SERVICE**



Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.


If faucet drips, operate HANDLE several times from "off" to "on." Do not apply excessive force.

# Clogged CARTRIDGE outlets or inlets may cause reduced flow.

- Remove INDEX BUTTON (1), loosen HANDLE SCREW (2) and remove HANDLE (3).
- Remove the HANDLE CAP (4). Unthread the PLASTIC NUT (5).
- Lift CARTRIDGE (6) off MANIFOLD (7).
- Clean MANIFOLD (7) and CARTRIDGE (6) ports.
- Place CARTRIDGE (6) onto MANIFOLD (7) and tighten MOUNTING SCREWS (5) alternately.
- Replace ESCUTCHEON CAP (4), HANDLE (3), tighten HANDLE SCREW (2) and install INDEX BUTTON (1).

#### Clogged AERATOR may cause reduced flow:

- Unthread the AERATOR (8) with a coin or flat head screwdriver and clean it of any debris.
- Allow water to run through the faucet with no aerator to flush the hoses.
- Reinstall AERATOR (8).
