Replacement of PC Board

Application:

- 1. The Priority Zoning Circulator is a standard "00" with built-in relay and transformer.
- 2. Each unit is equipped with a priority switch. The switch allows the installer to choose the zone that requires the most priority and when activated, only that circulator will run.

Installation:

- 1. Refer to instruction sheet number 102-054 for any questions regarding the basic installation of the "00" circulator.
- 2. Refer to instruction sheet number 102-070 for any application information regarding a Priority Zoning Circulator.

Replacing the PC Board of a Priority Zoning Circulator:

- 1. Disconnect the electrical supply.
- 2. Open capacitor box cover.
- 3. Unplug and remove old PC Board.
- 4. Snap in new PC Board.
- 5. Reconnect PC Board plug.
- 6. Disconnect terminal strip wiring from the old board and reconnect to the new board, one wire at a time.
- 7. Close capacitor box cover.
- 8. Restore electrical power—Observe all applicable codes when connecting to the power supply.
- 9. Test zone and circulator operation.
