Nokorode Aqua Flux is a creamy, smooth paste. Aqua Flux is water washable, so it may be flushed from the piping system and limit the corrosive effects found in other fluxes. It is lead-free and may be used with all types of soft solder, including 95/5, 60/40, 50/50 and 40/60 solders. Unlike other "gels" or liquid fluxes, Aqua Flux will not run or drip off acid brushes, pipes and fittings during application. The outstanding wetting characteristics of Aqua Flux assure a superior joint.

Nokorode Aqua Flux is certified to NSF/ANSI/CAN 61 in compliance with AB1953 (Low Lead Law) requirements making it suitable for use with the silicon family of metal alloy products.

Directions for use

- 1. Clean surface before soldering.
- 2. Do not breathe vapor during soldering operations.
- 3. Stir and apply a small amount of flux evenly to both joining surfaces. Heat and apply solid wire solder in normal manner.
- 4. When joint has cooled, wipe outside with a wet rag, and flush inside surfaces thoroughly with water.
- 5. Flux paste may liquefy if stored under very hot conditions (usually greater than 120°F).
