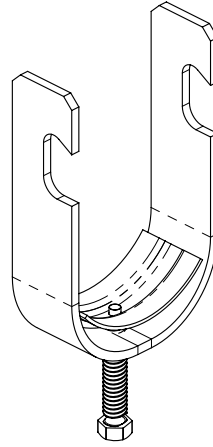

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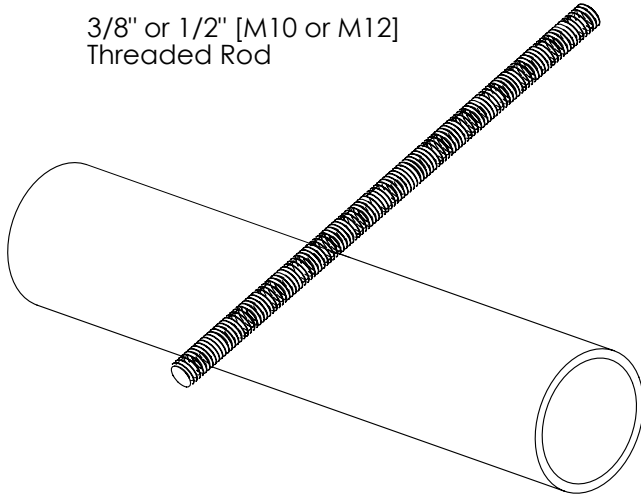


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Branch Line Restraint Device

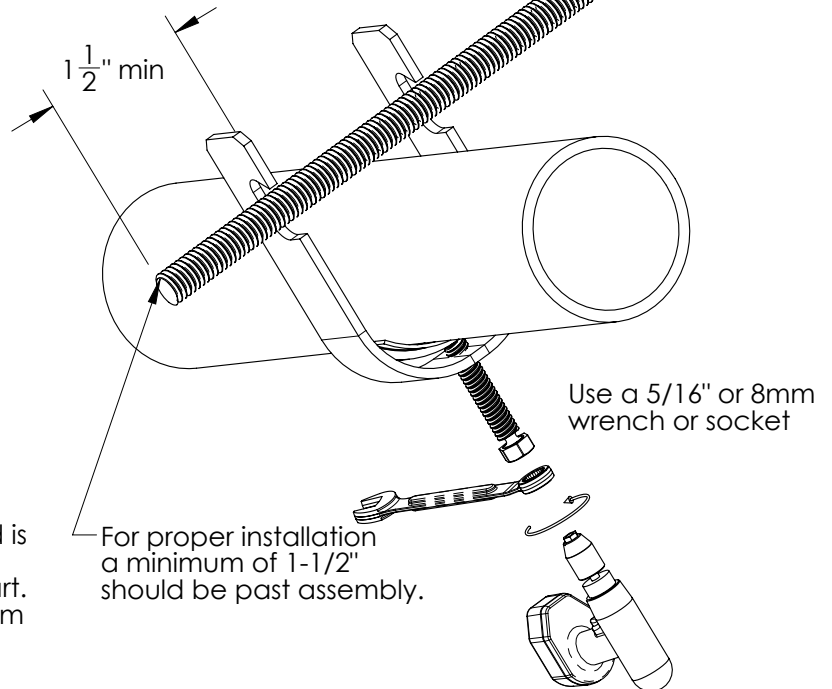
Step 1

3/8" or 1/2" [M10 or M12]
Threaded Rod



Some slight bending of threaded rod is acceptable and will not harm the performance or installation of the part. Rod can be installed on top or bottom of pipe.

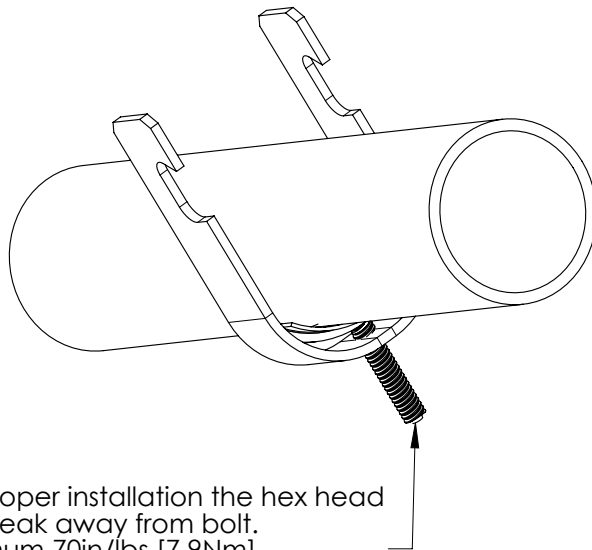
Step 2



For proper installation a minimum of 1-1/2" should be past assembly.

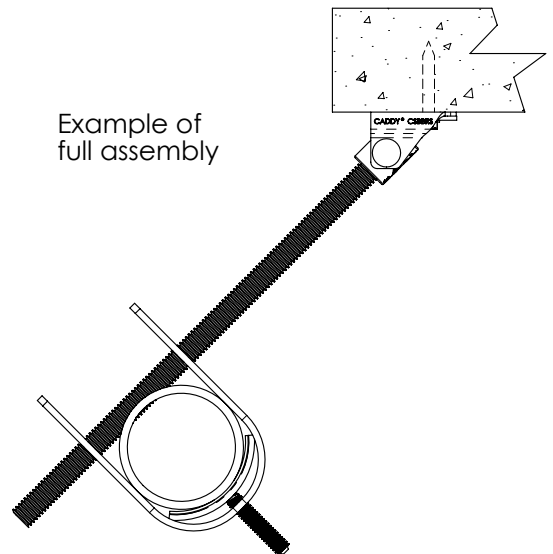
Use a 5/16" or 8mm wrench or socket

For proper installation the hex head will break away from bolt. Minimum 70in/lbs [7.9Nm]

Example of full assembly



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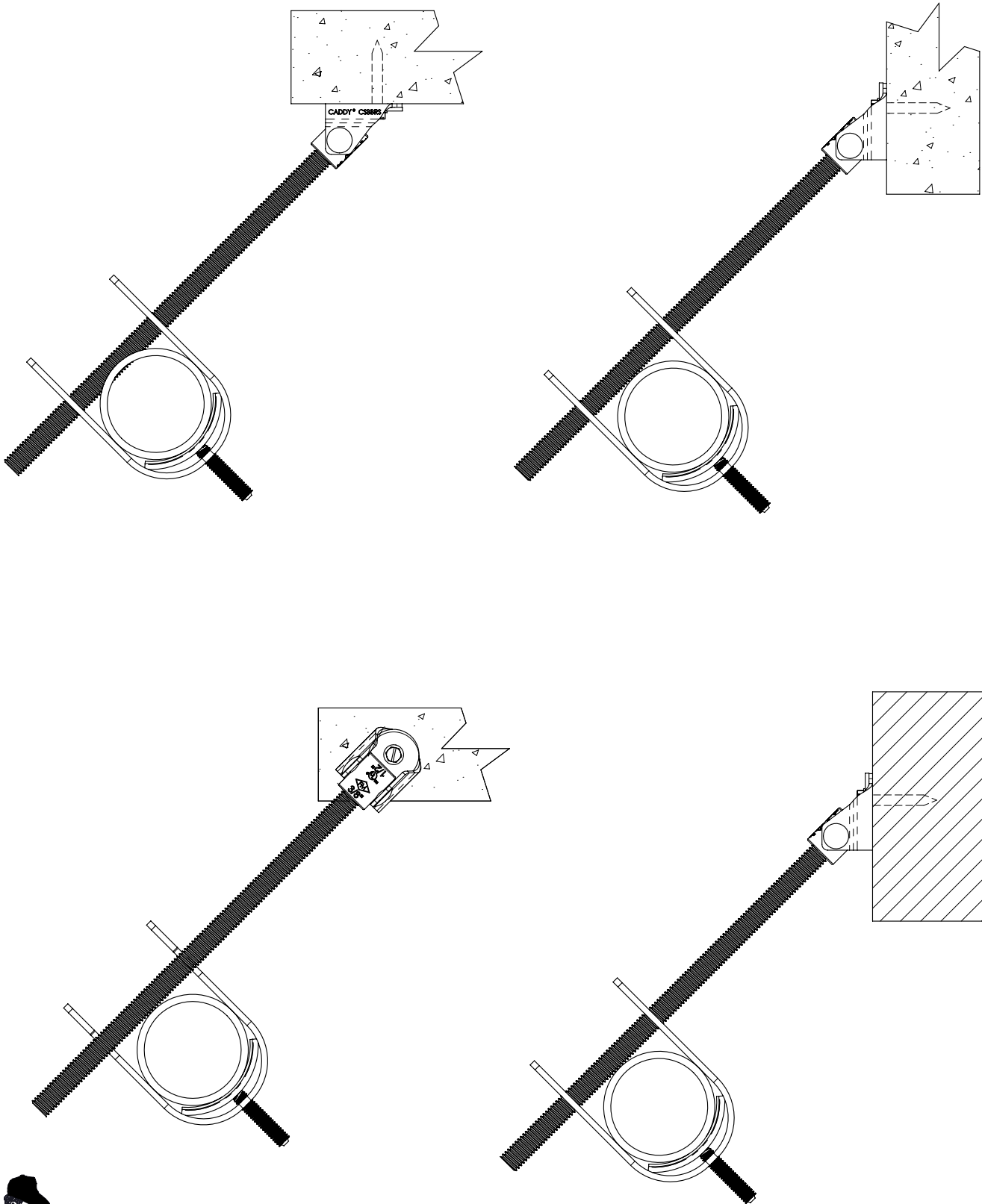
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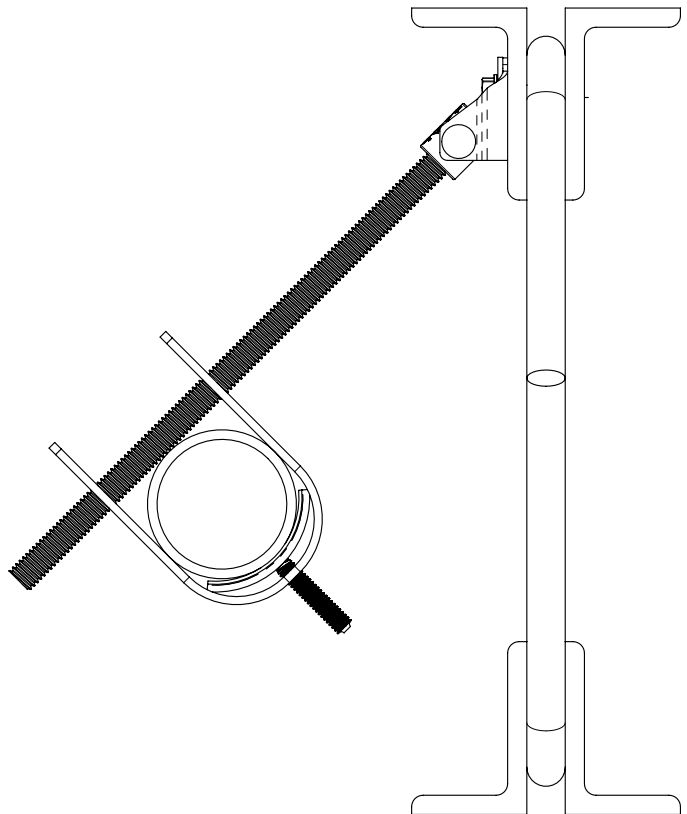
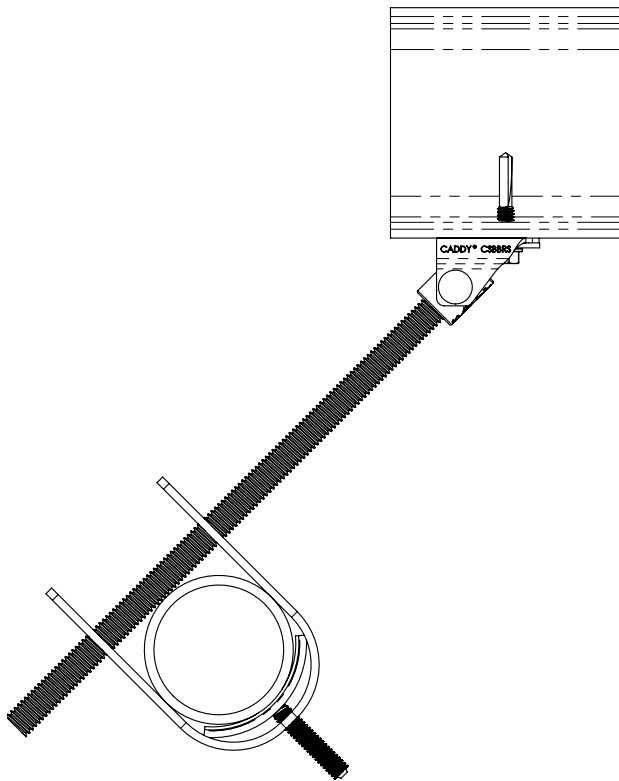
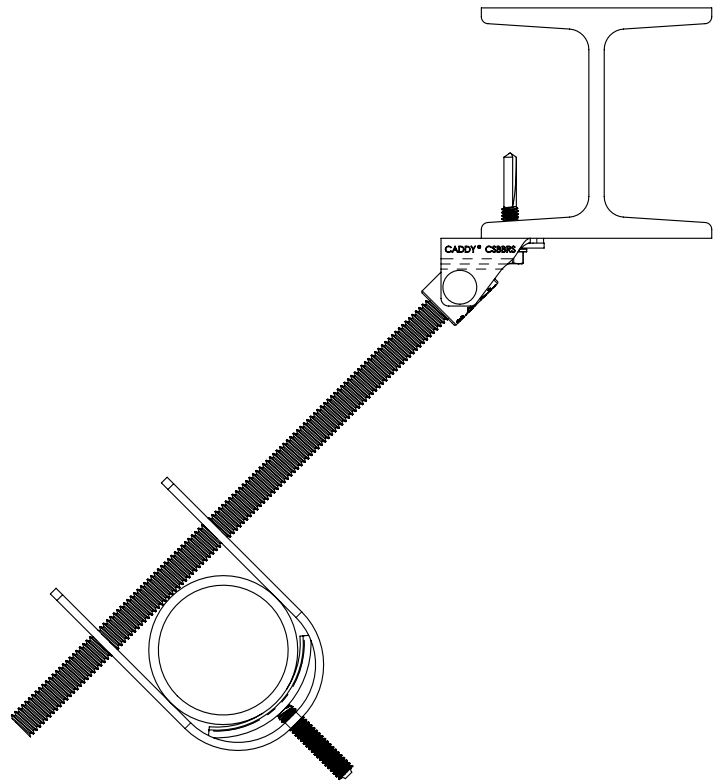
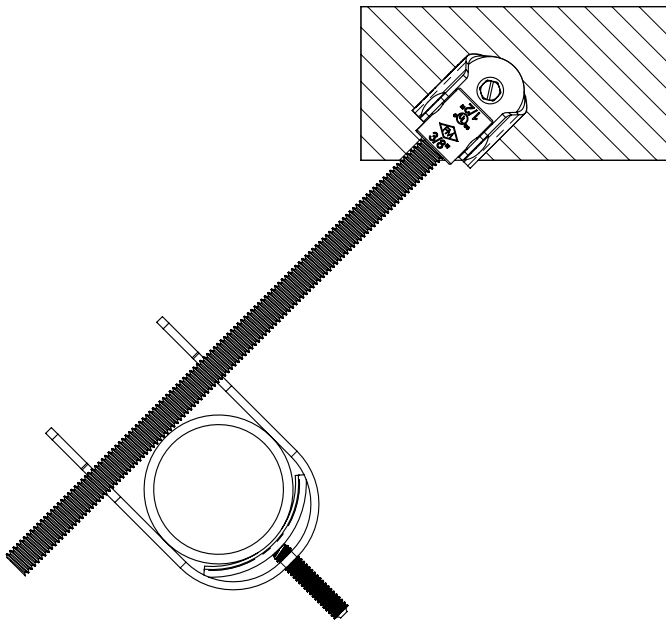
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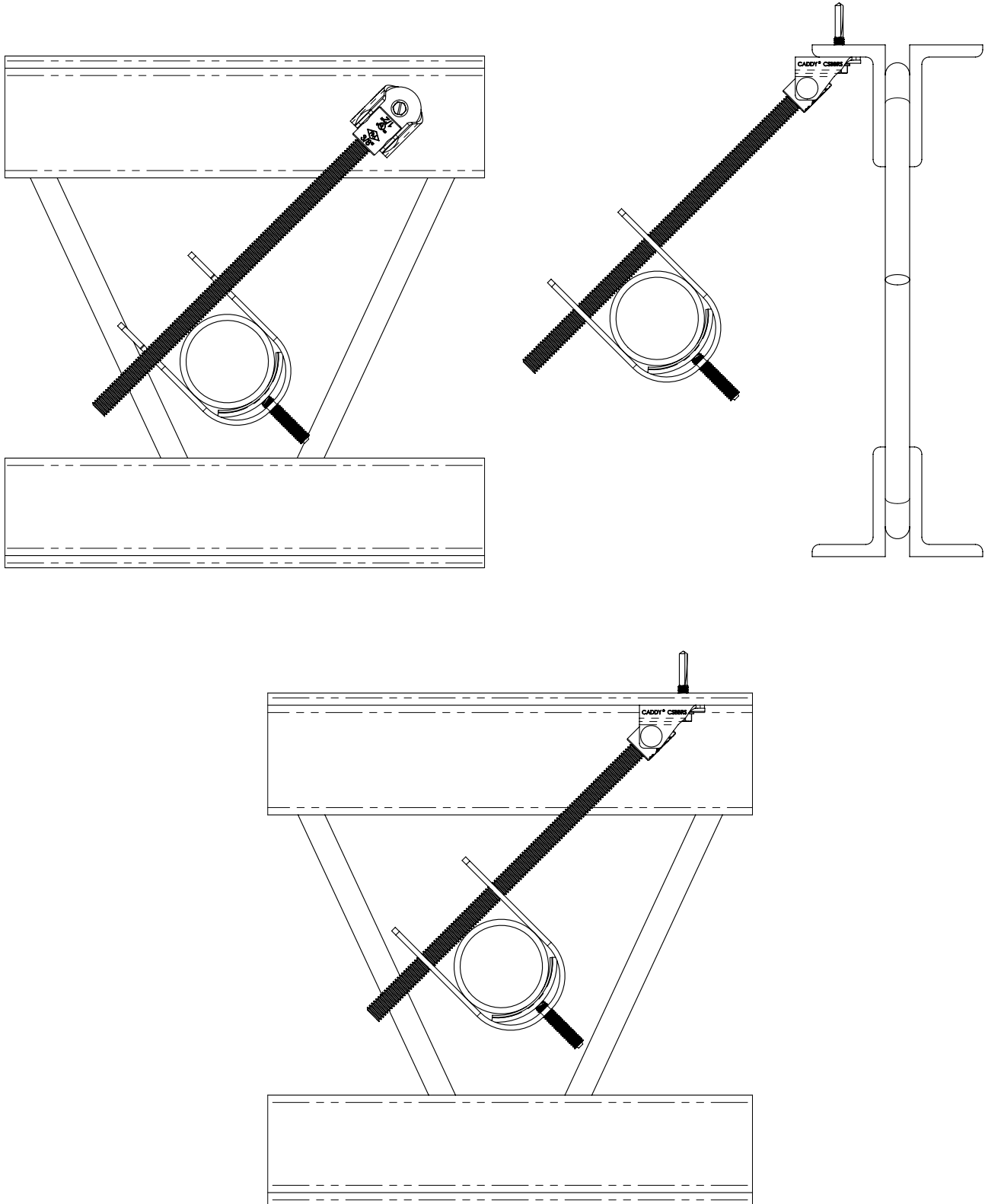
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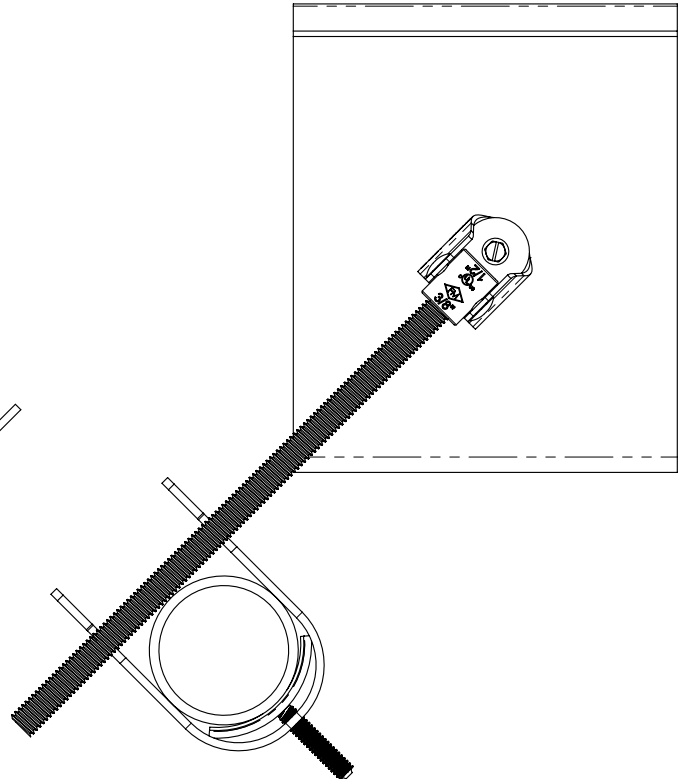
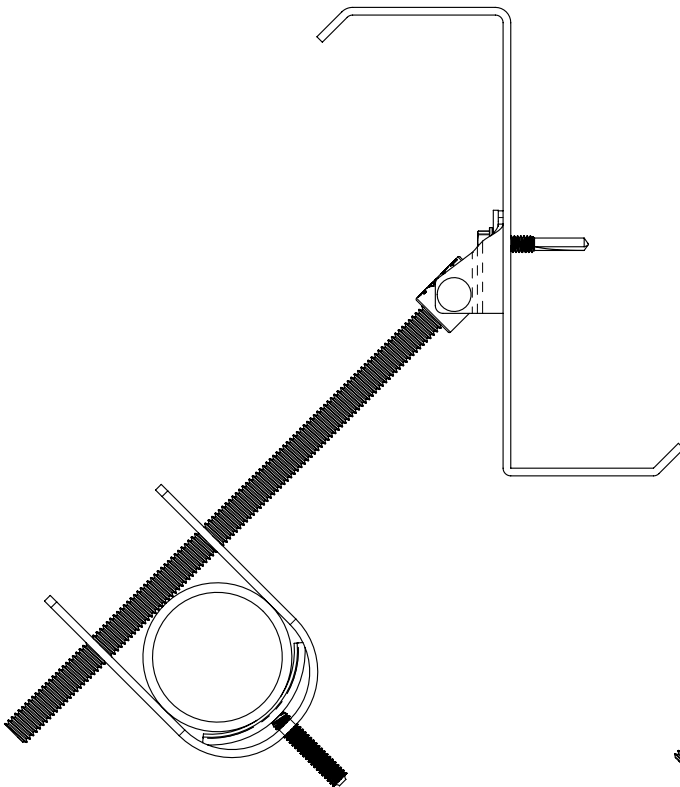
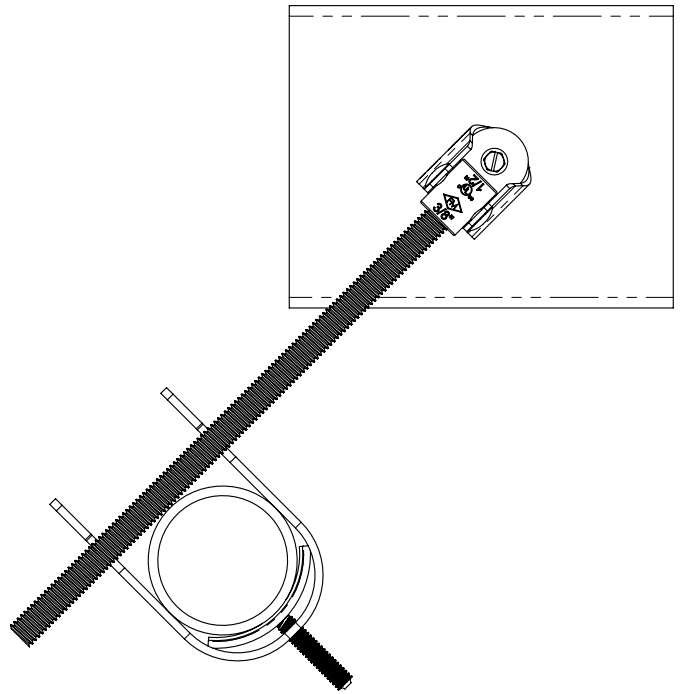
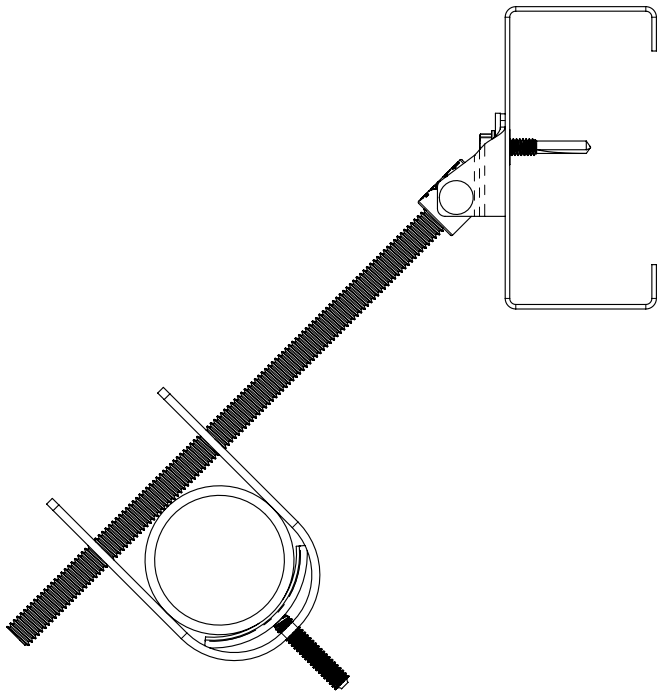
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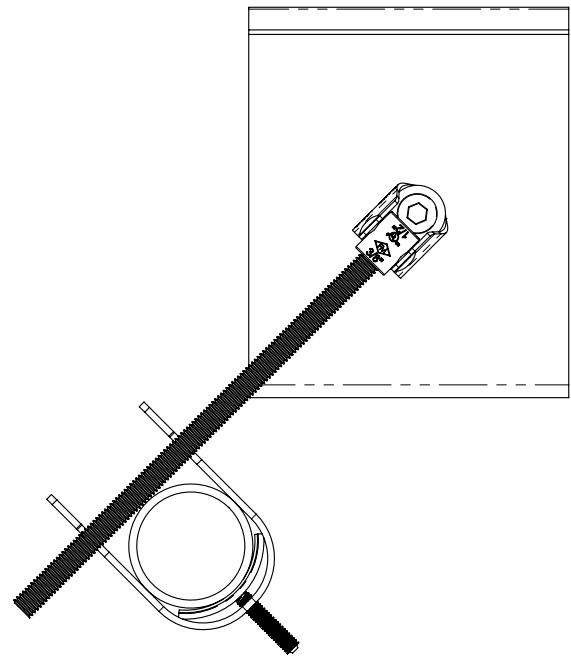
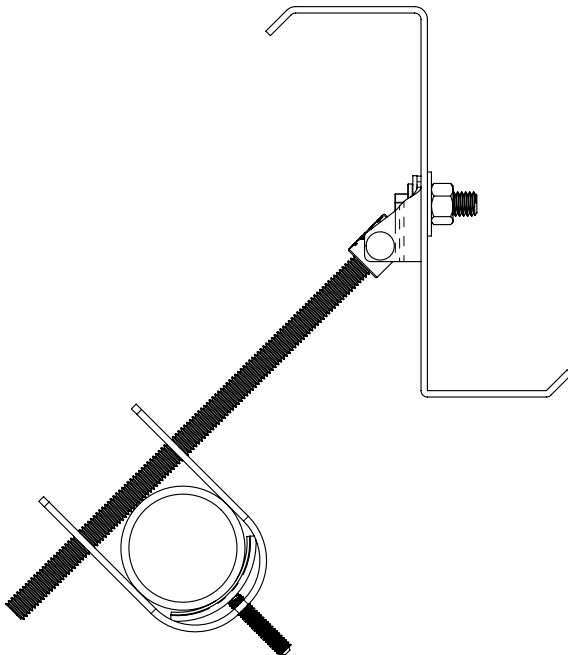
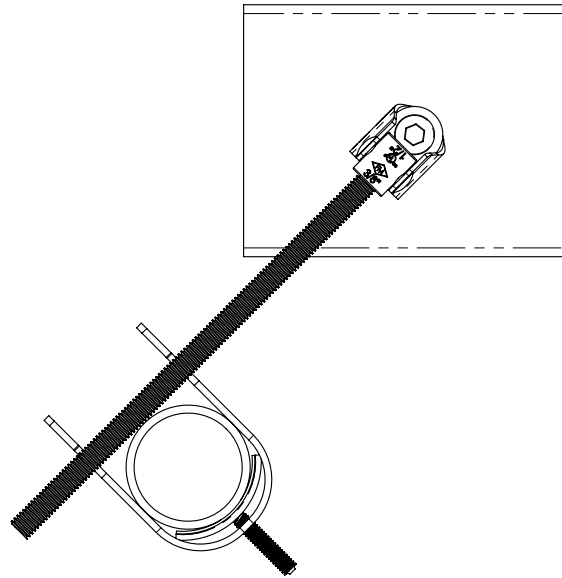
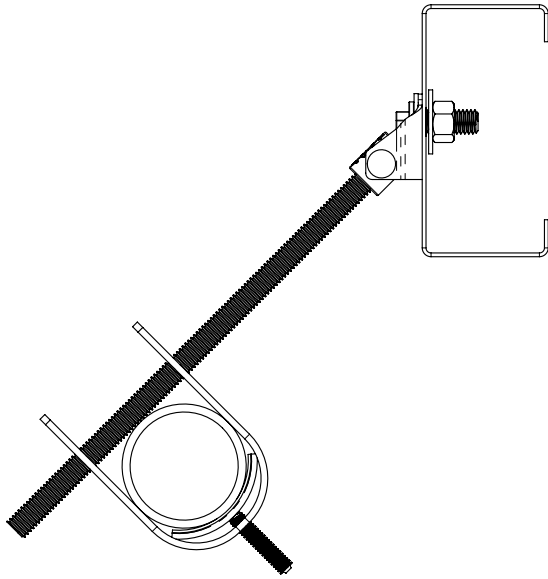
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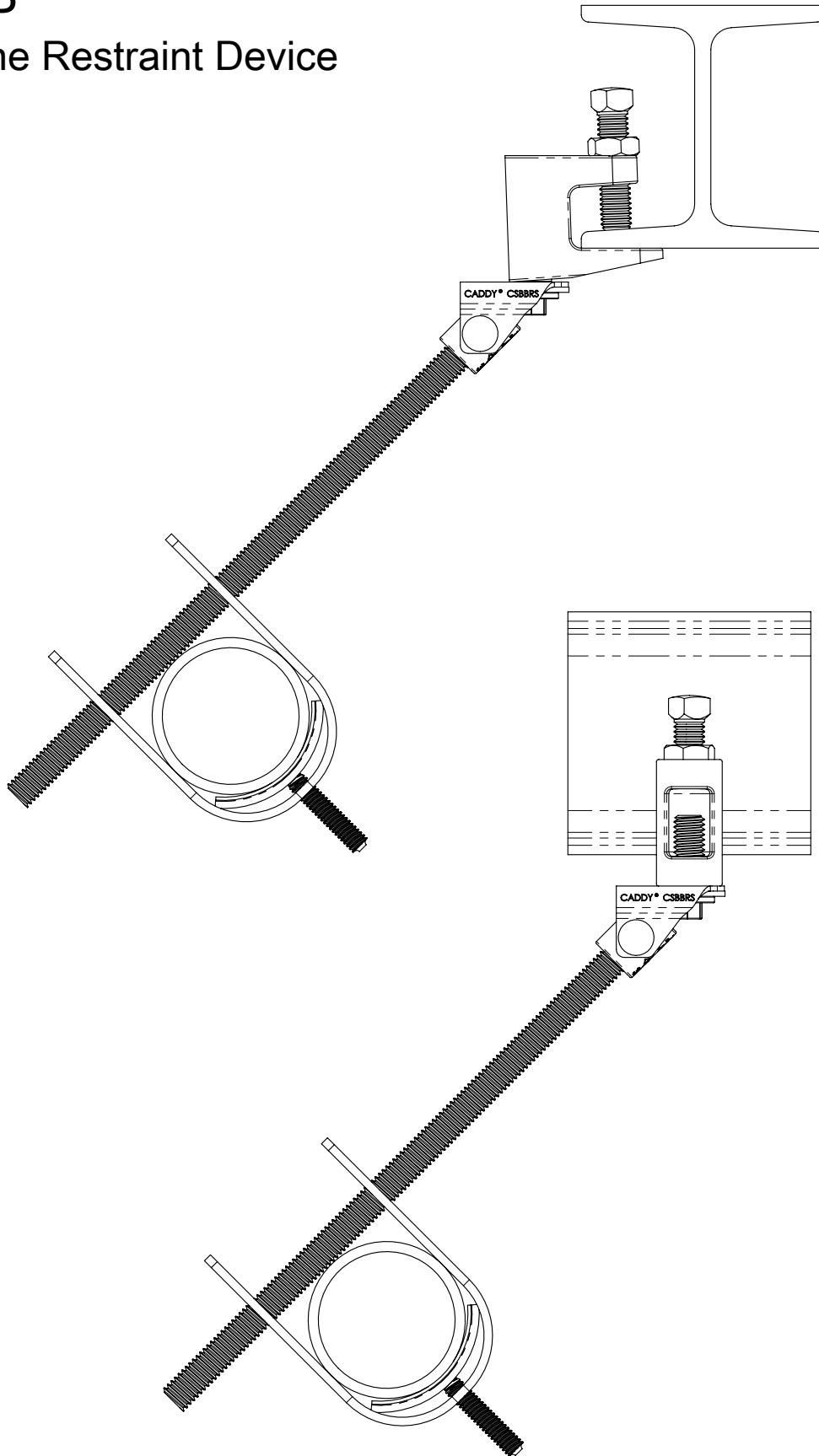
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
