Lyme disease is caused by tick bite and is caused by the bacterium *Borrelia Burgdorferi*, which is a spirochete-type bacterium. A common early indication of Lyme disease is a typical Target-shaped rash surrounding the tick bite. Many patients with Lyme disease also experience fatigue, fever, headaches and brain fog.

Hyperbaric oxygen also heals damage done by bacteria. Overall, it reduces inflammation, reduces the expression of inflammatory genes that doctors find in patients with Lyme disease, and helps reduce fatigue, brain fog, and boosts patients' immune systems. While 70% of our patients heal completely from their Lyme disease, up to 30% of patients have ongoing symptoms. There is no single solution to cure Lyme disease, though Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy does heal the majority of patients.
