

First Aid Policy

KGJ Price (Railway Contractors) Ltd., maintain a ratio of 1:50 staff who are trained in First Aid at Work. This is monitored by the HSEQ department, who manage competency and re-training via a competence database.

Where individuals are involved in works of a short duration, or transient worksites, First Aid boxes will be provided within vehicles. It is essential that the contents of the First aid boxes are monitored, and maintained with adequate stock Levels.

If the type of work involves higher than normal risks for staff working on track, a risk assessment shall be carried out and a new ratio applied for that specific project.

Site Specific Method Statements or Work Package Plans will detail the first aid arrangements on site, although the Company generally expect the Client or Principal Contractor to provide adequate facilities.

Arrangements will be reviewed with any contract that requires a presence on site.

Adequacy of First Aid cover is reviewed at management meetings.

Special consideration will be given to availability of first aid for staff working alone.

This policy and supporting arrangements will be reviewed at least once annually
