

It is the policy of KGI Price [Railway Contractors] to seek to ensure as far as is reasonably practical, that all steps are taken by the company to prevent and minimize the effects of fire.

KGI Price [Railway Contractors] acknowledges its responsibility for the safety of people within the Group if fires occur, for the prevention of fire and the requirement to have a written statement of general policy under the statutory requirements of:

- Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005, short ref RR/FSO
- The Health and Safety at Work Act 1974
- The Building Act 1984 and Building Regulations 1991
- Fire code Policy and Principles 1994

The company policy, together with any subsequent revisions, will be brought to the notice of all company employees and candidates.

KGI Price [Railway Contractors] recognises its responsibilities to ensure that reasonable precautions are taken to provide a safe working environment and that steps are taken to prevent or minimize the causes of fire, in compliance with relevant statutes and code of practice (as identified above).

In pursuance of this aim, the KGI Price [Railway Contractors] will:

- Provide a safe working environment paying attention to fire prevention and evacuation procedures.
- Ensure that systems are in place and regularly scrutinised to ensure their adequacy, i.e. fire evacuation drills, inspections of the means of escape and maintenance of fire warning systems and firefighting equipment.
- Provide appropriate information, suitable instruction and training in basic fire prevention measures and evaluation procedures, together with mandatory annual updating for all people of the group.
- Ensure all legally enforceable obligations are complied with, for designated use premises, under the Fire Precaution Act 1971.
- Ensure Risk Assessment and Fire audits are implemented to comply with statute.
- Ensure all premises have a local Fire Safety Procedure that is regularly reviewed.

KGI Price [Railway Contractors] recognises that this Policy Statement is implemented in pursuance of this aim.
