

Global Employability University Ranking 2022-2023 (GEURS): emlyon business school is ranked #2 of the best business schools in France by international recruiters

On November 23rd, Emerging, the Human Resources agency, published in the Times Higher Education, its 12th annual ranking of the best 250 higher education institutions in terms of employability. emlyon ranks #41 in the world's top 50 of best business schools, and #2 in France, behind HEC.

Following the 2023 Figaro ranking, in which emlyon business school reached the 4th rank of the best business schools in France, the School stands out this time as #2 in the Global Employability University Ranking 2023 of the best business schools in France in terms of employability.

The GEURS ranking assesses the reputation of institutions and of their graduates from the **recruiters' perspectives**. This year, the **Emerging agency** collected **99,000 votes from employers of 24 different countries** to rank the **best 250 international higher education institutions among the 1,000 ones present in the world**. emlyon business school and its graduates were graded and judged as performing outstandingly by recruiting managers in 6 criteria reflecting the great strategic orientations of the School:

1. Skills (hard, soft & digital skills)
2. Specialization
3. Professional experience
4. Digitalization
5. Academic excellence
6. Internationalization

Just one day apart, the GEURS 2023 ranking echoes the **Figaro 2023 ranking of the best French business school** published on November 22nd, in which the international outreach of emlyon business school is also praised (#2 in France behind ESCP), along with the quality of its Faculty and Research.
