



The International MBA of emlyon rises up 13 ranks in the Financial Times' world ranking

The International MBA of emlyon business school soars 13 places and ranks #76 in the 2023 Financial Times world's ranking, and #22 in Europe. It is especially praised on the environmental, social and governance criteria, ranking #12 worldwide, and on the career progress criteria.

Our outstanding result in the **Career Progress** criteria, in which **emlyon** ranks **#3 in France**, is particularly indicative of the quality of this program which provides **guidance** and **support** to the participants' **ambitious professional projects**.

The International MBA of **emlyon** business school also stands out on differentiating criteria, in keeping with the school's mission, such as the **environmental, social and governance criteria** (#12 worldwide). The program has been entirely revisited in order to reinforce the training of **International MBA** participants to **ecological transition, social sustainability** and **ethics**.

The data used for the Financial Times' ranking are collected via two online surveys: the first one is filled in by the participating schools, and the second one, by alumni who graduated from that program three years prior to the survey.

Meant for professionals with a 5-year experience, the **International MBA** of **emlyon** business school provides a set of learning experiences allowing to develop pertinent skills for their **career progress**. Taught in English, it is an 11 to 16-month full-time program, with a 90% rate of international students, with over 30 nationalities represented. It is a state-controlled Master's degree allowing graduates to integrate jobs all over the world.
