## CROSS COUNTRY CLUB OF DALLAS

The familiar Dallas phrase, "wait ten minutes and the weather will change" was in vogue the day before and during the White Rock Marathon. The preceding day saw 60-70 degree no-wind weather while marathon day grew colder as it lengthened. For the second year in a row high northerly winds either lifted or stiffened the 230 starters on various loops of the course.

A relocated Terry Zeigler did not defend his '75 title which left world class distance star, Don Kennedy all alone in front of the pack. Don's pace was well under his 15th place Boston effort in April of '75 when he logged a 2:18. His final time of 2:25:29 was a workout none the less due to the winds and closing pressure from Roger Vann in second.

Roger, NAIA champion from John Brown University, closed the gap on Kennedy a few seconds during the race and was able to open up on Dennis Dierckman on the last loop to garner second place with room to spare.

The race for fourth was exciting all the way as Mike Matheny, Nolan Grayson, and Brian Harrington came together with 500 yards to go only to have 33 year old Matheny burst ahead and hold off Grayson. Nolan, who has had several outstanding marathons in the past, spent much of the race ahead of Matheny only to fall back on the third loop, close the gap, and then to be outsprinted in the end. Exciting to watch this duel as a spectator.

As with many outstanding marathons, the real stories come from the legions who compete and complete! Weather played much of a role on the few non-finishers, however White Rock again produced a large percentage of finishers as compared to starters. Of the 178 finishers, 128 were under 3:30 and 56 were under 3 hours.

## FACTS & HISTORY THE WHITE ROCK MARATHON

The White Rock Marathon was the brainchild of Talmage Morrison, one of the founders of the Cross Country Club of Dallas, and its President for the first three (3) years. Following the lead of the American National Marathon of Galveston, Talmage set out to establish a first rate event that would serve as a focal point to the distance running activities of the North Texas area. The original course went completely around the lake two times and then out two miles and back.

Four days after the completion of the 1973 White Rock Marathon part of the road on the west side of the lake was torn up and rerouted by a capital improvements program of the park. The 1974 White Rock Marathon, under the direction of Ralph Taite, marked the shift to a 3 loop course on the flat east side of the lake. This fast course, used in 1974, 1975 and 1976 has been the site of many personal bests. Until Jeff Wells super 2:17:45 at the 1976 Houston Marathon, White Rock had been the site of both the fastest men's and women's time in Texas.

The six prior White Rock Marathons are capsulized below:

### 1971

March 6, 1971. The inaugural White Rock saw 82 entrants including 2 women toe the starting line. Following a course which circled the lake twice (11.1 miles each loop) and then down 2 miles and back, Little Rock, Arkansas school teacher Ricky Richardson outdistanced Wayne Comes of Houston 2:38:09 to 2:40:11. The noon starting time saw cool temperatures melt away and the famous White Rock winds buffet the runners. Nevertheless 61 runners finished. Annabelle Corboy was the only woman finisher with a time of 4:12:25. Twenty-three runners bettered 3:30 with eight going under 3 hours.

### 1972

March 4, 1972. Noon saw 143 entrants greeted by a starting temperature in the lower 60's and a 15 mph wind. North Texas State's Paul Hoffman, running an even paced run, blasted to a 2:23:18. At age 19, Paul's run was one of the best at that time ever run by an American Junior. Gary Tuttle, now American record holder at 10 miles, 20 km, and 1 hour held off fast closing Wayne Comer 2:28:24 to 2:28:54. Four of the women finished with Terry Stansky at 3:49:29 leading the way. 109 finished with 46 runners besting 3:30 and 21 cracking 3 hours.

## 1973

March 3, 1973. Warm weather pushing temperatures to about 70° greeted the 155 runners in the 3rd White Rock Marathon. Wayne Comer twice a bridesmaid easily outdistanced the field finishing over 6 minutes ahead of Ronnie Hess in the time of 2:37:45. Four women finished lead by Patti Price at 4:27:45. Thirty-three of the 107 finishers slipped under 3:30 and 14 cracked 3 hours.

## 1974

February 23, 1974. A new starting time of 9:00 a.m. and a new course partially necessitated by destruction of the part of the lake road greeted 159 runners. Temperatures were in the low 40's and the famous White Rock winds were quiet until about 10:30. Terry Ziegler and Don Kennedy came through the first of three loops at a sub 2:14 pace. At 10 miles they were 51:00 and 51:01. Slowly pulling away, Ziegler came home in 2:19:18 with Kennedy at 2:21:34. Kathy Loper lead the three women finishers with 3:13:48. Eighty-three of the 125 finishers were under 3:30 and 34 bettered 3 hours. For Ziegler it marked his 12th marathon and 6th victory, but this one thrust the Oklahoman into national prominence with his first sub 2:20.

## 1975

February 22, 1975. The cold winds blew and the rain came down in buckets to greet 219 starters. Terry Ziegler repeated as champion with a time of 2:26:07. Mike Albert with a stron finish edged Hank Pfeifle 2:27:43 to 2:28:19. Kathy Loper defending her women's title splashed to 3:00:54 as ten women finished in this Aquathon. Overall 167 runners finished with 123 bettering 3:30 and 46 sneaking in under 3 hours. Dorothy Doolittle, later in the year to run the 10th fastest marathon ever run by a woman (2:51:22) showed her promise with a 3:09:47.

## 1977

Looking ahead to 1977, we might see changes in the White Rock route. A projected bike and hike path should be completed by that time as well as changes in Park policy concerning the race running along Northwest Highway. Regardless, the 7th White Rock Marathon should continue the traditions of being one fine Marathon.
