**T**his was a year of many "firsts" for the 23rd running of the Dallas White Rock Marathon: For the first time, 3700 runners entered the Marathon—the largest field in our history. We added a 5K fun run to the festivities, and the first "Rock Around Downtown" attracted more than a thousand entrants.

Also this year, Dallas Mayor Steve Bartlett proclaimed the White Rock

Marathon "The Official Race of Dallas" and challenged local celebrities to run the 5K with him. More than 125 CEO's and other notables accepted his 5K challenge, then stayed around to cheer for you marathoners.

And for the first time in our history, the Dallas White Rock Marathon offered prize money to our top finishers. All of these "firsts" are steps towards our goal of making The Rock one of America's top five

marathons. But we'll always maintain the traditions that make The Rock a true "runner's race."

In 1992 the Dallas White Rock Marathon continued to attract runners from all over the map—eight foreign countries and forty-four states. 83% of those who started the Marathon finished it, reinforcing our reputation as the ideal marathon for first-timers as well as veterans looking to set a PR or win some money.

*Runner's World* counted The Rock among its favorite marathons again this year, as did numerous other polls. In 1992 we extended our reputation as one of the most "runner-friendly" races in the country, with more than 1,600 race volunteers (one volunteer for every 2.3 marathoners!) pitching in to make your run at The Rock a memorable event.

Once again our world-famous, raucous, rollicking, and rowdy aid stations kept you motivated as you pounded out the miles. And as usual, the weather was unpredictable—cloudy and cold at the start, followed by sun. Of course, it was windy around the lake (isn't it always?).

The Rock's most important tradition is the generous support we receive from our corporate sponsors—Texas Instruments, MassMutual, American Airlines, ARA Services, and the Tom Landry Sports

Medicine and Research Center. They give us the financial support we need to make the race better and better each year. New supporting sponsors joined us this year, too: Harvest Burgers, Seiko, American Federal Bank, and The Amend Group.

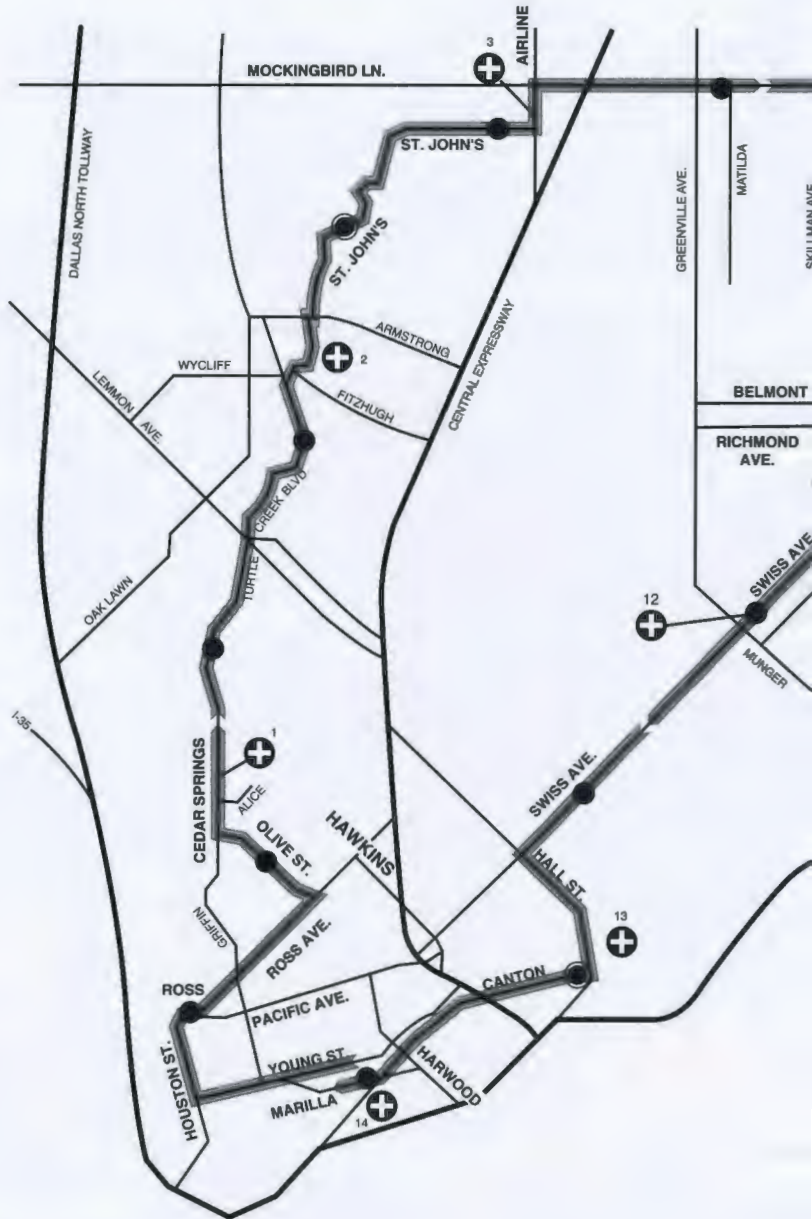

The Dallas White Rock Marathon course starts and ends at Dallas City Hall. After passing through some of the old and new areas of downtown, the course proceeds up Turtle Creek Boulevard and through the Township of Highland Park. It then goes out

Mockingbird Lane for the traditional loop around White Rock Lake, returning to City Hall through the scenic Lakewood area and historical Swiss Avenue. Fourteen fully staffed and equipped aid stations are spread at approximately two-mile intervals to

cheer the runners on.

The 1992 Dallas White Rock Marathon was certified by The Athletics Congress (TAC Certification Number TX 86078KL), and is a qualifying event for the Boston Marathon.

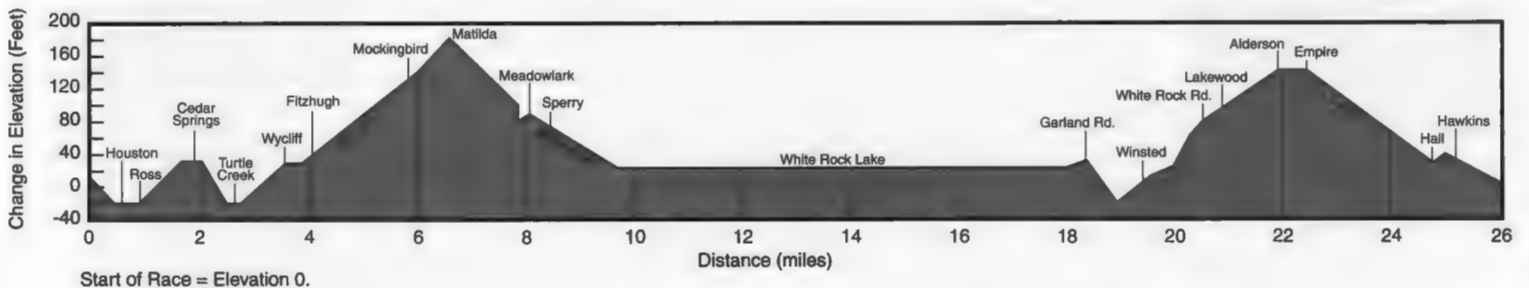

In the marathon, strategy is often confused with opportunity. Necessity, in hindsight, is frequently mistaken as brilliance. And providence, well, providence shines on us all at one time or another.

For the winners of the 1992 Dallas White Rock Marathon, there was a little mixture of each of these things.

Let's start off with the weather. Clearly providence shone upon the race in the form of precipitation or the lack thereof. The temperature was a tad brisk (35 degrees at the start), but considering the late-week forecast called for freezing rain, it was a Godsend.

As the record field of 3,700 registrants (topping the old 3,636 mark of 1983, the year the race moved downtown) shivered their way in front of City Hall, no runner could be certain if he or she had what it took to claim the \$3,000 first prize, the \$1,000 second-place purse or the \$500 for third. This was, after all, the first time in 23 editions The Rock had opened its wampum pouch to reward the runners for their efforts.

Certainly J. P. Worcester was uncertain ... probably even doubtful. After all, there was Greg Lautenslager, the running scribe for The Dallas Morning News, whose world-class credentials at the 5,000 meters (four consecutive U.S. Olympic Trials) made him a formidable opponent. And there was Isidro Salinas, who had finished 15th at the 1992 Houston-Tenneco Marathon in 2:18:33. And Wesley Brown, a two-time winner of the Cowtown Marathon. Up near the front was David O'Keefe, a 2:18:30 finisher in Chicago only a year ago. Even Dan Chraska was there. Chraska had predicted a 2:20 and he had little marathon experience.

And way out front was Peter Schouw of

Shawnee, Oklahoma, who seemed to be so confident that he was striding along, seemingly effortlessly, at 5:09 pace.

Back in the trailing pack, Worcester was content to stay at 5:20 pace and watch the race

unfold. Who knows, he thought, what might happen?

Schouw kept the hammer down through 10 miles. He passed halfway in 1:06:57, which was awfully fast for this field. At the

midway point, he was trailed by O'Keefe in 1:07:42, Salinas in 1:07:56 and William Moore, a Dallas physician, in 1:08:28.

And there, in fourth place at 1:08:58 was Worcester. Was this strategic? "I was with the second pack but they seemed to want to slow down," Worcester said. "I wanted to stay at 5:20 pace, so I kept going." Whether it was strategic or merely opportunistic, Worcester wasn't certain. He merely wanted to stick with his plan, and if he was to have any chance to win, he, by necessity, must abide by his scheduled pace.

As it turned out, the plan was brilliant. For up front, Schouw, who had slowed his stride 40 seconds per mile, was stopped

cold by a call to the bushes, which caused him to give way to O'Keefe just past the 18-mile mark. But O'Keefe almost immediately began to show signs of fatigue as he started up the Lakewood hills at 20 miles. And suddenly, there was Worcester, who had been picking off the leaders like a sniper, he passed Schouw on the Dolly Parton hills just past 20. Then he quickly reeled in O'Keefe, dispatching him at 20 1/2 miles.

"When I passed those guys, I really wanted to blow past so they wouldn't try to challenge me," said Worcester, a former NAIA All-American at Fort Hays State. "Once I was in the lead and it was all downhill to the finish, I just tried to hold on."

It is here that providence smiled once again on the 32-year-old grain merchandiser from Lindsborg, Kansas. Although he'd dropped significantly off his 5:20 pace, he had put enough distance between himself and the field that no one could catch him.

And so it was that Worcester, a one-time runner-up at this event (he finished second in 1987) claimed his first marathon victory. A little strategy, a little luck and \$3000 to call his own.

Meanwhile, back in the pack, the race was on for second place. Chraska had noticed just prior to the Lakewood hills that Lautenslager was only a few strides back. Chraska knew that his leg speed would be no match for the former Nike Boston runner once the course leveled out again, so it was now or never.

"I knew Greg was back there, and wanted to get away from him," Chraska said. "I didn't want him to be anywhere near me on the flats. So I made a move and he didn't come with me."

The strategy was a success. Lautenslager, who was having his doubts about his ability

to finish the race in one piece and who was seriously questioning his sanity for moving up from 5,000 meters to 26.2 miles for the final race of his competitive racing career, didn't cover the move.

"I felt if I'd gone with him, they might have taken me off the race course a couple of miles later in a body bag", he said.

By the time Lautenslager realized he would survive and that it was time to give chase, Chraska had a good but not insurmountable lead. But somehow, in the midst of the chase, both runners were passed by a blur in the form of 33-year-old Trevor Fieldsend, a Brit who lives in Stillwater, Oklahoma. Fieldsend, who's run a 2:16:32, had pace himself a bit slowly and found he had more reserves than he'd planned. He charged into second place, although much too late to catch Worcester, but fast enough to finish in 2:23:04 and claim the \$1,000.

"The group broke up on the hills, where I was about sixth," Fieldsend said. "I'd kind of given up, but at the top of the hills I felt pretty relaxed, so I found another gear and cruised in."

In the meantime, the battle for third was getting tight. Chraska knew Lautenslager was on his heels, and he

could only hope that he'd given himself enough of a cushion to reach City Hall ahead of his pursuer.

He almost didn't. Lautenslager was charging, but his batteries were awfully low, and in the end, Chraska claimed third with an 11-second advantage.

"It would've been great to go out a winner in my last race, but I'm just amazed it turned out the way it did," Lautenslager said. "I'm amazed I got that close. I passed three runners in the last three miles, and I was jogging."

Unlike Worcester, Mary Level-Menton came into the race with strong credentials and was immediately tabbed the heavy pre-race favorite. Stands to reason that someone who had finished 17th at the women's U.S. Olympic Marathon Trials last January in Houston and owner of a 2:37:09 PR would be seeded No. 1 in a race like The Rock.

But Level-Menton wasn't so sure. She was nursing a cold and she'd not been at

her best. Besides, she hailed from Coral Springs, Florida, where thermals are wind currents and not something you put on to

run a marathon. To say she was uncomfortable in the morning chill would be understating things a bit.

"I thought I would be able to run a 2:45 here," said Level-Menton, 29. "I had heard it could be cold, but I didn't think it would be this cold.

"That was a big factor. I got really, really cold and my legs started getting tight." But cold or no cold, Level-Menton was the class of the field. However, she found company in the form of Mimi Corcoran, of Mendon, Massachusetts. Corcoran and Catherine Lifschultz, her teammate on the Boston Running Club, had come down together. They didn't have Level-Menton's credentials, but they both were very fit and planned to run well.

And for the first 15 miles, Corcoran was the runner to watch.. She and Level-Menton were together until the 16th mile, when a leg cramp caused Corcoran to slow.

"I've never had a problem like that before," Corcoran said. "I was cruising and then all of a sudden I got a severe cramp in my calf. I couldn't hold on after that."

Level-Menton took advantage of the opportunity to take the lead, but with 10 miles to go, she began having problems of her own. The wind around White Rock

Lake was taking its toll on all the runners. Her legs tightened up and her stride shortened. Then, at 20 miles, she began suffering intestinal cramps. But fortune smiled as no runner overtook her and she managed to keep it together for a 2:48:58 finish and \$3000 first prize.

After Corcoran began suffering leg cramps, Lifschultz caught her at the south end of the lake as the runners passed the spillway.

"She was walking at about 19," Lifschultz, 29, said. "I asked her if she was OK. She said she couldn't run on it."

Lifschultz ran on to finish second in a personal best 2:51:22 and claimed \$1000. Corcoran struggled but finished third in 2:56:36, marking the first time in eight marathons she hadn't set a PR.

While the open races drew most of the attention, they were not the only prize

money events in the race. The Masters competition also featured \$500 for first place. And for the second year in a row, Terry Ziegler, 42, claimed the men's title in 2:40:37. Debbie Peebles, 41, of Tyler, won the women's championship in 3:04:01.

For Ziegler, it marked the second time in his long running career that he'd won two Rock titles back to back. In 1974 and '75 he was the overall champion.

Peebles has been the top U.S. finisher at the World Cup 100-Kilometer Championships the past two years. She used the race as a training run for an upcoming 100K and said she planned to use the money to finance her trip to the U.S. 100K Championships.

In the wheelchair competition, Todd Freeland, 36, of Beaumont, won the title in 2:00:40. Mike Lyon, 35, of Austin was second in 2:42:40.

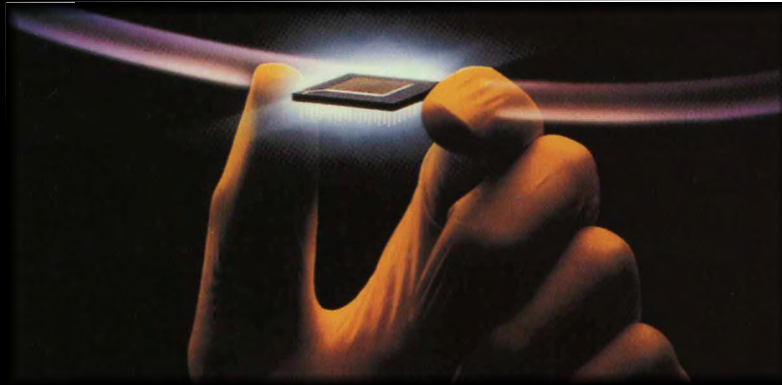

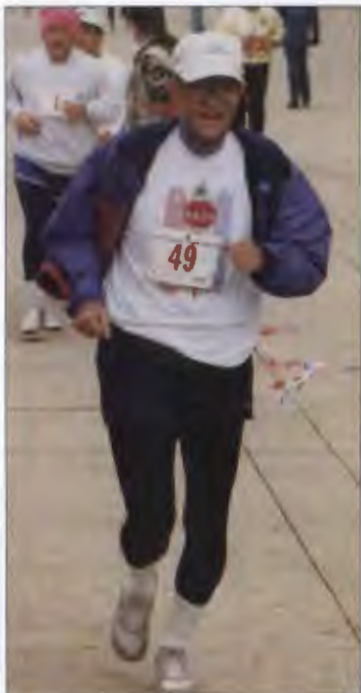

**W**hat do the Dallas Cowboys, Pro Football Hall of Fame, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, and "hats" all have in common? It could only be one thing: Thomas Wade Landry, or better known to most people as "Coach" Landry.

Tom Landry is the 1992 Dallas White Rock Marathon Award for Excellence recipient. The award was presented to Tom at the Marathon's pre-race dinner on December 5 by former Dallas Cowboy, Jethro Pugh.

The Award for excellence, sponsored by The Staubach Company, honors individuals who have demonstrated the positive effects of health and fitness through outstanding personal effort, determination, commitment and courage.

Candidates for the prestigious award have demonstrated one or more of the following characteristics: made major contributions to the sport of running or the Dallas fitness community, overcome significant physical impairment or personal injury, undergone a major lifestyle change through running or health and fitness, had a major impact

on the lifestyles of others, or achieved outstanding performance in running or health and fitness.

Previous winners include New York City Marathon Director Fred Lebow, "Mr. Boston Marathon"

Vaughan, President and founder of the Cooper Aerobics Center, Dr. Kenneth H. Cooper, and Kenny Moore, Olympic runner and writer.

Tom Landry was born in Mission, Texas in 1924. His football career began as a fullback in high school prior to earning All-Southwest Conference honors and co-captaining the Texas Longhorns to an Orange Bowl victory in 1949. He then went on to play for the New York Yankees, the NFL's New York Giants, and earned his All-Pro honors in 1954. Tom

Landry joined the Dallas Cowboys in 1960 and led the team to many victories including two Super Bowl wins.

Throughout his career, Tom Landry has been an inspiration to the Dallas fitness community. Landry's stature in the coaching profession remains unsurpassed. He was appointed Chairman of the Dallas International Sports Commission and was honored by Baylor Hospital in 1989 with the naming of the Tom Landry Sports Medicine & Research Center in

Dallas. His public speaking appearances explaining the difficult balance between his personal, religious and athletic life are both entertaining and motivating.

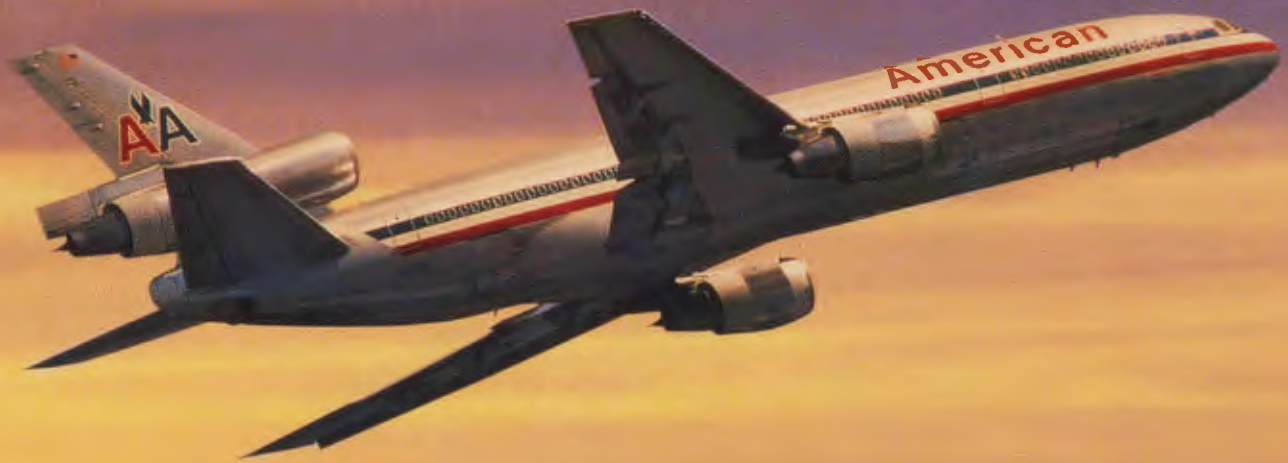
