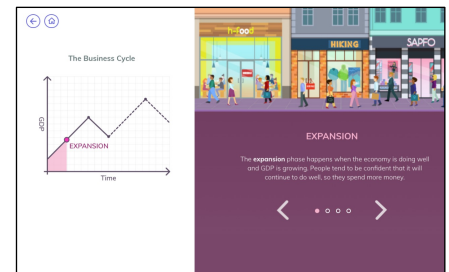


Credit and Debt
