




Video Type: Extension Lesson

WATCH:

Extension Lessons are compilations of video scenes put together into a game or interactive format. **Longer in length**, they run about ten to twenty minutes, providing multiple opportunities for practice, longer discussions, or review.

We have lessons than span all age and difficulty levels, but these are intended for **moderate-high functioning students** who can attend for the length of the video (for students at a lower level feel free to simply play one clip at a time).




An example of an Extension Lesson video


Our Think It or Say It Social Skills in Action lesson
