Vision 2020+ is the company's strategy for now into the future. The company's stated purpose is to serve society, to create value for all stakeholders and to make real what matters.

Siemens Smart Infrastructure recently launched a smart building suite that pairs smart office design with real-time analytics.

In late 2019, the company launched an independent energy company, Siemens Energy, as an effort for a more sustainable energy process. By 2030, the gas turbines will burn 100 percent hydrogen.
