Dear Patient:

Thank you for choosing the doctors at Victoria Eye Center as your eye care providers. We look forward to seeing you for your appointment. An appointment reminder card is enclosed.

Please take a few moments to complete the enclosed personal data/insurance information form and bring it along with you on the day of your appointment. We also ask that you bring the following items or information with you:

- All of your insurance cards and a driver's license or other form of I.D. (required) so that we can make copies
- A list of your current medications (or bring the actual medications)
- A list of the surgeries you have undergone
- A list of any known allergies

You can expect to be in our office at least one and a half to two hours for your exam. At the time of your visit, your eyes will be dilated. If you feel this might cause you to have difficulties driving after the exam, you might want to consider bringing a driver with you for your convenience.

Patients under 18 years old <u>must</u> be accompanied by a parent or <u>legal</u> guardian.
