

1. What is the application process for the Trainee Solicitor Programme?

Step 1: The first step of the recruitment process is to submit your CV and Cover Letter to hr.ireland@fieldfisher.com. Please make sure to document your personal and academic achievements along with any work experience you may have.

Step 2: Once the HR team have reviewed all applications, successful candidates will be selected for interview. If you are successful at our one to one interview with our HR team, you will be invited to attend a second round interview where you will meet with two Partners in the Firm.

Step 3: All candidates who have been successful at interview will be invited to participate in a group assessment.

Step 4: Trainee offers will be made to successful candidates.

2. Can I apply for future years?

Yes. We are now accepting applications for our 2023 and 2024 Trainee Solicitor Programme.

3. How many Trainee's do you recruit per intake?

This varies from year to year however; on average, we typically recruit five to seven trainees in each intake.

4. When will initial interviews take place?

We plan to commence our initial interviews mid-late November 2021.

5. Will my Law Society fees be paid by the Firm?

Yes, the Firm will pay your PPCI and PPCII fee's in full.

We will also provide full remuneration whilst you attend and complete your PPCI and PPCII course.

6. What is the Trainee Salary?
