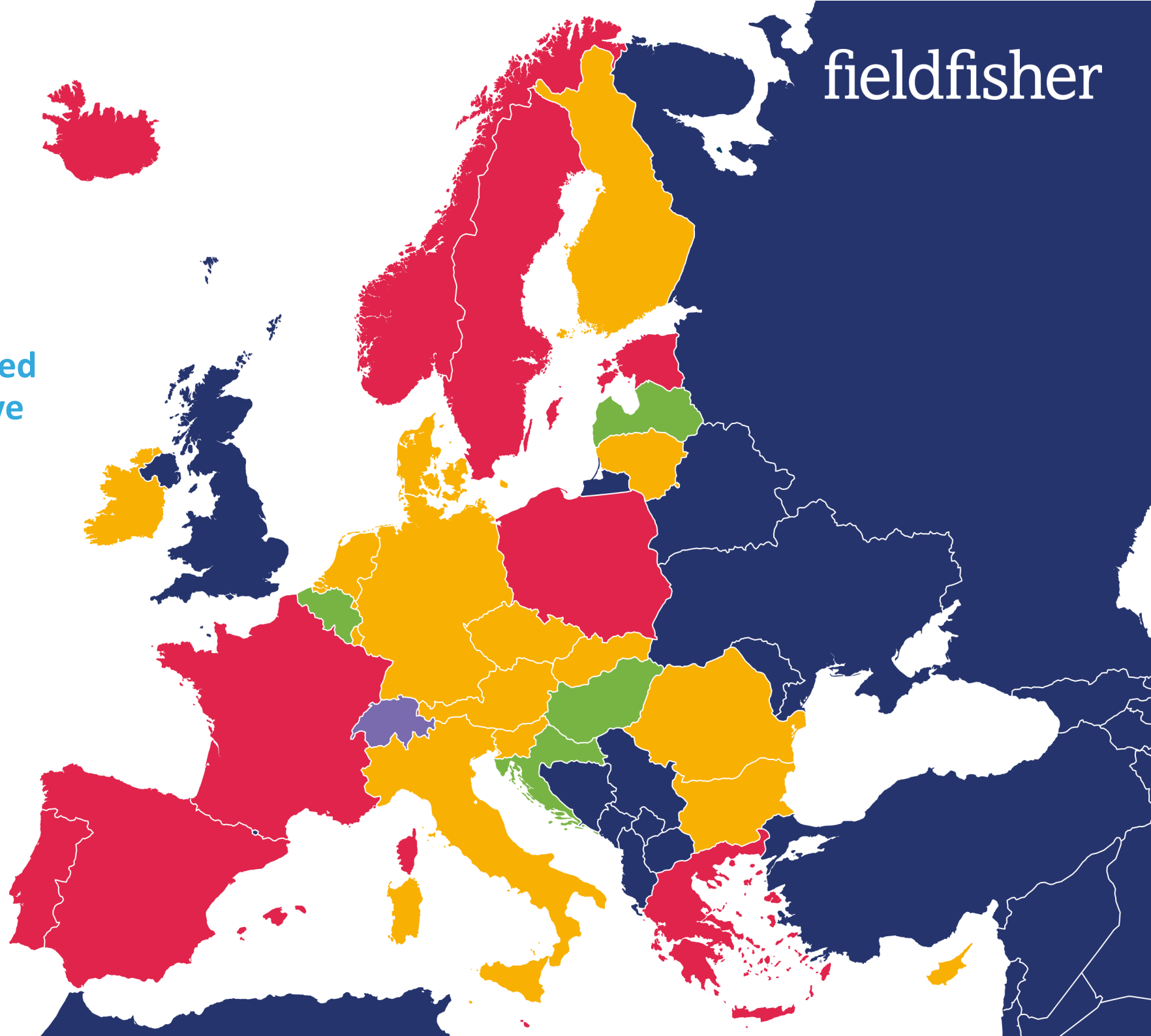

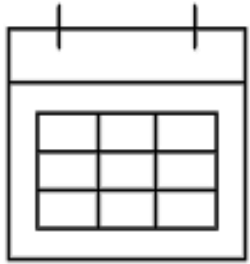

# NIS2 across the EU

The implementation deadline for the EU's landmark Directive 2022/2555 on cybersecurity (NIS2) is fast approaching.



17 October 2024

**Key changes:** Among other features, NIS2:

- significantly widens the scope of entities and sectors that will be regulated for cyber security;
- imposes much more prescriptive requirements on cyber security risk-management compared to other legislation like the GDPR; and
- sets out new enforcement measures which could have significant impacts on management bodies.

**Current implementation status:** In collaboration with our relationship firms across the EU, our market-leading European Cybersecurity team is delighted to have produced this NIS2 status update. Our latest map (accurate as of early September) shows that many states are likely to miss the 17 October 2024 deadline to implement the Directive into local law.

Only 4 Member States have implemented NIS2 into local law and 8 Member States have not yet published a draft law. The other 15 Member States have published draft laws but it remains to be seen which ones will be implemented in time.

**What next?** Businesses operating or providing services in the EU need to assess if they are in scope of NIS2, what they need to do to comply and where they will need to register. These are not simple questions and different thresholds and tests apply to determine what local laws are relevant.

We will be following up with further commentary on some of the important features of these local laws as we near the 17 October deadline.

In the meantime, it has been interesting to see that Hungary is requiring all entities operating in Hungary to

register there, deviating from the 'main establishment' principle for certain providers set out in the NIS2 Directive. Also, it currently looks like the EEA countries of Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein will implement NIS2 although this may still take several years.

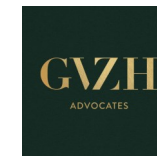
