International Ski Federation Announces Partnership with Conceptum

<u>Frankfurt/Oberhofen, 13 November 2013</u> – The International Ski Federation is putting its logistics for the transportation of Snowboarding and Freestyle technical equipment into the hands of Conceptum Sport Logistics (CSL).

Cooperation between FIS and CSL will also include the logistics of the transportation of technical equipment for the upcoming Olympic Winter Games in Sochi. And – just like sport – you need a bit of training to make sure the performance goes well!," says head of logistics, Sebastian Stahl.
