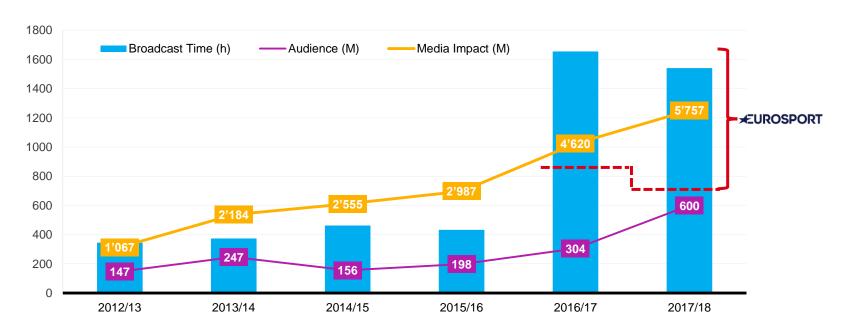

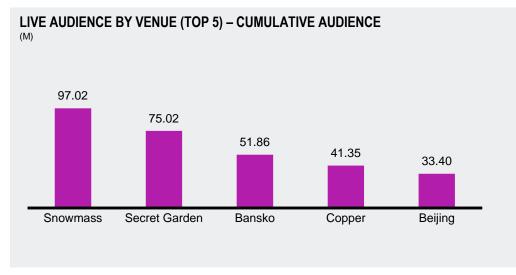
Broadcast coverage trend (broadcast hours, cumulative audience and media impact)



- FIS Snowboard World Cup 2017/18 reports a slight drop in the 18 countries that were monitored for broadcast coverage compared to the 2016/17 season. Notable markets responsible for the decline are Austria, Italy and Spain, whereas countries such as the USA, Sweden and Finland report growing broadcast coverage.
- Eurosport increased its overall broadcasting time and thus features a greater share of total broadcast coverage compared to other channels.
- It is important to note that although overall broadcast coverage time declined, the cumulative audience, and with it media impact increased considerably, growing by 97% and 25% respectively.

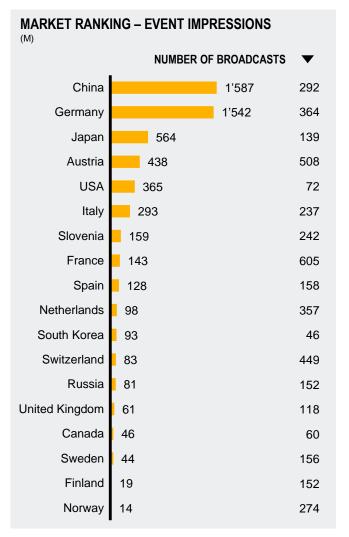

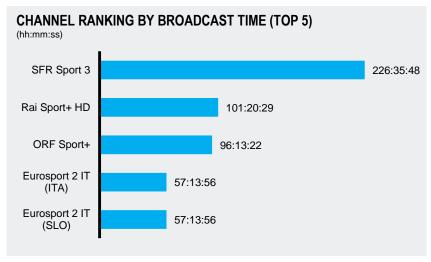


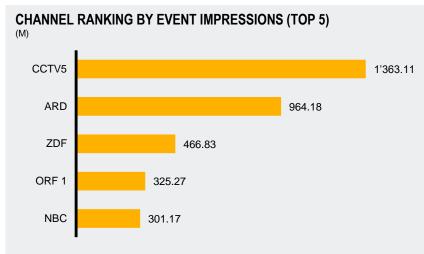
- The Halfpipe and Slopestyle races in Snowmass lifted the venue to top rank for cumulative live audience with over 97M viewers. Other notable events were the Secret Garden Halfpipe competitions and the Parallel GS and Snowboardcross competitions in Bansko.
- The Top 5 venues in terms of live (cumulative) audience for the FIS Snowboard World Cup 2017/18 accumulate for over 40% of total audience.
- China and Germany remain top-ranked (1st and 2nd) in event coverage. Coverage in Japan made a huge leap forward, moving the country from 16th to 3rd overall position in total event impressions. To a large extent, this growth can be explained by extended broadcast coverage on NHK and TBS.
- Halfpipe in Secret Garden and the Big Air event in Beijing generated the greatest media impact for single events with 721M and 641M event impressions. This competitions together generated a similar share of total media impact this season.

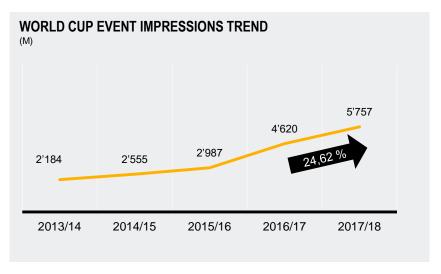

- As in the 2016/17 season, China again contributes a huge portion of media impact and audience, for the major part by CCTV5, which aired over 27h (10h more than 2016/17) of Snowboard broadcasting, generating 1,36bn event impressions and over 73M cumulated viewers.
- 60% of the media impact was generated by the top 5 channels: CCTV5, ARD, ZDF, ORF1 and NBC, by order or importance.
- These top 5 channels also contributed 35% of the cumulative audience. This is 13% less than what the top 5 Channels contributed last season.
- In the 2017/18 season, cumulative audience and media impact of live coverage increased by 256% and 246%. As a result, delayed coverage no longer carries more weight than live coverage.

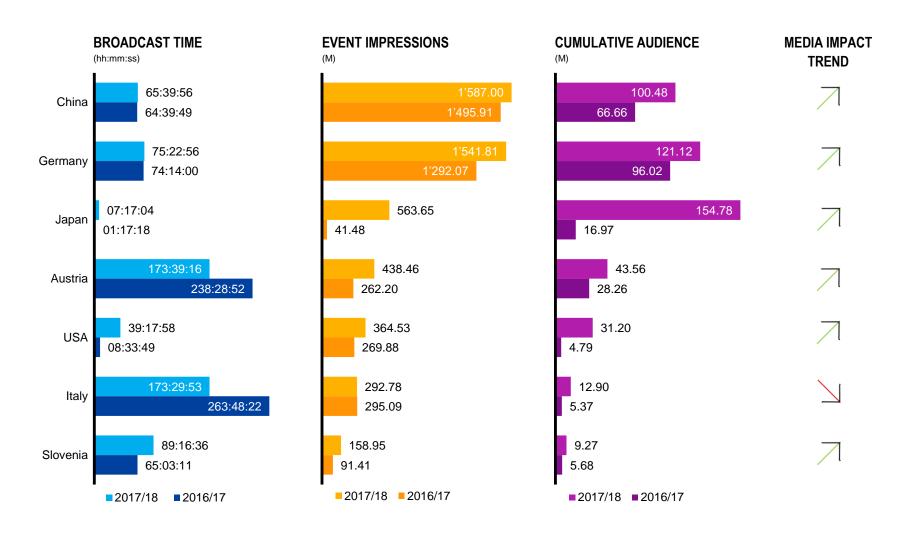

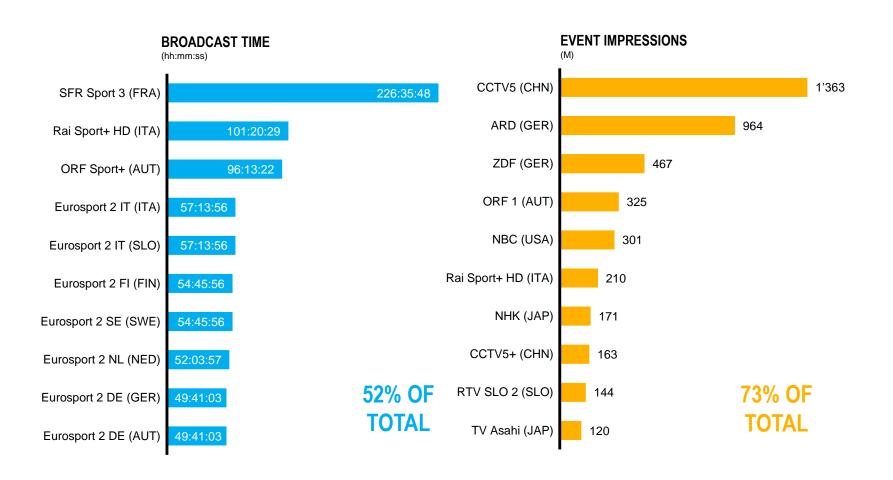

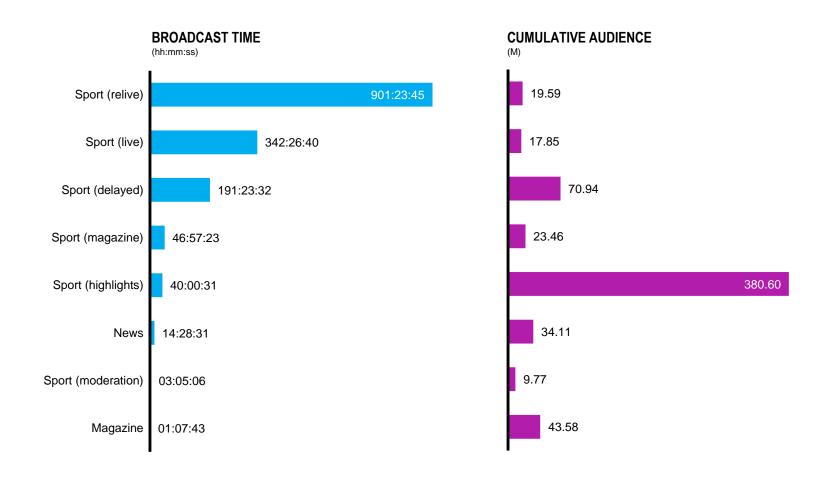
By Channel (Top 10)





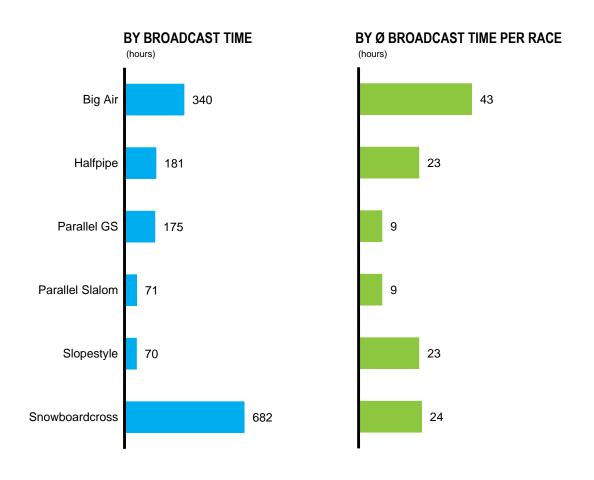
By Programme Type





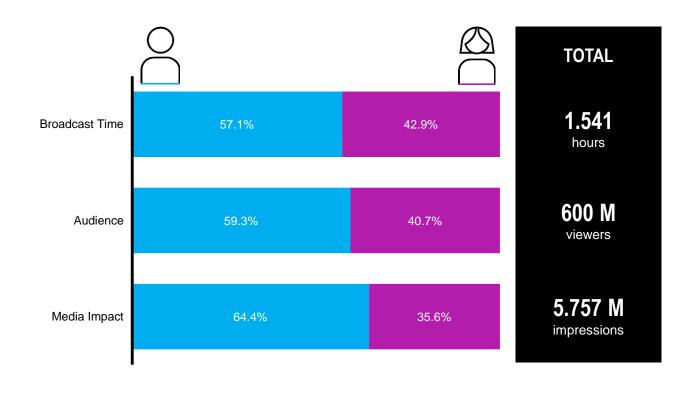

Comparison of Genders



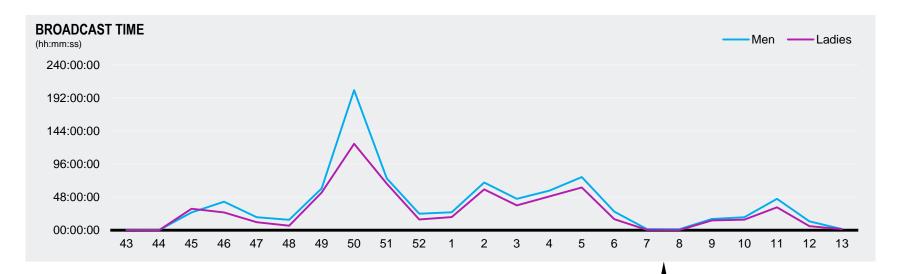


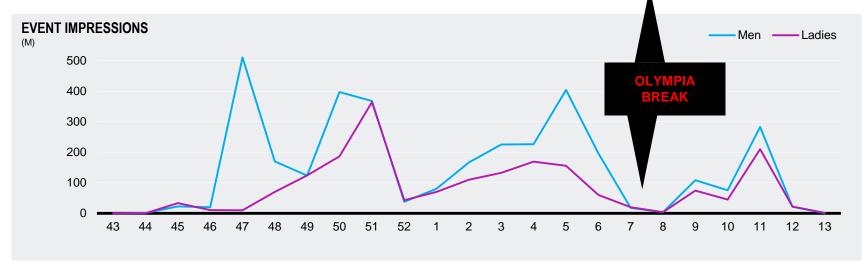
