

## The International Matteo Baumgarten Award 2019

The International Matteo Baumgarten Award commemorates the life of Matteo Baumgarten by recognizing young athletes who whilst competing are also completing their studies and education.

Limit on nominations: Each National Association may submit a maximum of 3 nominations.

**Disciplines:** Nominees maybe from the following disciplines: Alpine, Snowboard, Freestyle, Cross Country, Ski Jumping or Nordic Combined.

**Presentation:** The award will be presented in Italy after the completion of the northern hemisphere winter season.

**Prize Money:** The winning athlete will receive **2000Euro** with thanks to sponsors and partners of the award.

Eligibility: Eligible athletes must fulfill the following criteria:

- The award is open to both male and female athletes.
- The athlete must be between the ages of 18 and 24
- It does not matter if the athlete is at World Cup, Continental Cup, Europa Cup, Nor Am or FIS level.
- The athlete must be currently enrolled in university or college whilst also actively competing
- The athlete must be FIS registered

## Application deadline: 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

Additional Documentation: Please make sure that when submitting the application the following documents are also provided:

- Photo identification of the athlete
- Proof of matriculation (Scan will be sufficient)

Without the above documents the applications will not be accepted.
