

PREVIEW LADIES' CITY EVENT – Tuesday 1 Jan 2019

Shiffrin poised to complete city event hat-trick

- **Mikaela Shiffrin** is the only woman to have won multiple city events on the World Cup. She won in Stockholm on 31 January 2017 and in Oslo on 1 January 2018.
- **Lena Dürr** (Moscow 2013), **Wendy Holdener** (Stockholm 2016) and **Nina Haver-Løseth** (Stockholm 2018) are the other active female skiers to have won a city event on the World Cup.
- Shiffrin and Holdener have collected a joint-record three World Cup podiums in city events, alongside Veronika Velez-Zuzulová.
- Shiffrin has won eight World Cup races this season. Only in 2016/17 (11) and in 2017/18 (12) she collected more World Cup victories.
- **Holdener** won the city event in Stockholm on 23 February 2016, her first of three race victories in the World Cup. She also won two Alpine combined events in Lenzerheide (2016, 2018).
- **Haver-Løseth** has won the last city event in the World Cup, in Stockholm on 30 January 2018. It was her last World Cup podium in any event. She is not competing in Oslo due to injury.
- **Mélanie Meillard** finished third in last year's city event in Oslo, defeating Frida Hansdotter in the small final. It was her first and to date only World Cup podium in any event. She is not competing in Oslo due to injury.
- **Hansdotter** has participated in six World Cup city events, a record among women. Holdener, Michaela Kirchgasser and Bernadette Schild have participated in five city events.
- Hansdotter has yet to win a city event on the World Cup. Her best result is a second place in Stockholm on 23 February 2016.
- Hansdotter has finished in fourth place in the last three city events held on the World Cup.
- Hansdotter and Holdener have reached the semifinals a record four times in a ladies' World Cup city event. Shiffrin, Velez-Zuzulová and Haver-Løseth follow with three semifinals each.
- **Petra Vlhová** has won five World Cup races. The only skier representing Slovakia with as many or more World Cup victories is Velez-Zuzulová (5).
