New Hardwood Purchase

Here are some helpful hints to ensure a smooth, hassle-free, quality installation*.

When your install is scheduled you will be given an approximate time frame the installer will arrive at your home.

The ambient temperature in the home must be at least 70°F for 48 hours prior to the scheduled installation date. The installer will need electricity in your home.

For Existing Homes

- ✓ Please move all furniture (unless it's included in your bid).
- ✓ If furniture moving is included in your bid please be advised that our installers do not remove books, glass, small items, or unplug electronics. Please strip bedding, remove drawers from nightstands and dressers, etc. Have professionals move your pianos, safes, pool tables and grandfather clocks as we do not provide this service.

For New Construction

- ✓ Please be sure the floor is free of debris, sand, and dirt prior to installation.

Expansion and Contraction

- ✓ To minimize the natural expansion and contraction of your hardwood flooring, maintain a natural indoor relative humidity level of 30%-55% throughout the year. A humidifier is recommended to prevent excessive shrinkage of wood floors due to low humidity levels.

Routine Care and Cleaning

Use Area rugs. Quality area rugs inside entryways will prevent dirt and moisture from damaging your hardwood floor. Do not use rubber, foam brick or plastic pads as they may discolor the floor. Dust floors with a soft brush/mop, do not use vacuum-powered brushes/bristles. Clean the floor with a damp mop and manufacturer approved spray cleaner.

Vacuum or sweep your floors regularly. Vacuums with a beater bar or power rotary brush head can damage a wood floor and should never be used. Remove spills promptly using a clean dry terry microfiber cloth. Do not allow puddles to remain on the floor's surface. It is recommended that felt protectors be used under heavy pieces of furniture.

Never clean or wet mop your hardwood floor. Do not use any wax or cleaner that must be mixed with water, such as oil soap, as this may ruin your floor and result in the loss of warranty.

Direct, unfiltered sunlight exposure can damage wood floors.

We recommend visiting the manufacturer's web-site for specific care instructions.
