English Literature	-Poetry anthology removed
English language	-Video of spoken language assessment not required -Teacher can assess spoken language on a one to one, or small group basis. No requirement for an audience
Maths	No changes
Food	No NEA1 and the food exam for NEA2 is now only two dishes in three hours. Written exam remains the same.
Drama	 Live theatre review can now be a review of a pre recorded professional show. The devised performance can now be performed as a monologue rather than working in a big group. All written coursework and the written exam remain the same.
Science	No changes to the exams Required practical activities can now be taught via teacher demonstration/ video recording/ animated simulation
Design and technology	Reduction in the number of marks given for making and evaluating in the NEA. Students can make prototypes and are no longer required to make their final product NEA will still count as 50% of the overall GCSE qualification. No changes to the examination (50%)
Engineering	 Engineering skills section has been reduced from 15 to 10 marks students will no longer be assessed on the skill of making but will be required to show their 'intentions of prototypes' and demonstrate their understanding of the processes involved in making the assessment no longer requires students to make a final prototype - instead, they can show their understanding of the processes involved in making by writing about them. there's no expectation to test a final made prototype, but students should test their prototype designs. NEA will still count as 40% of the overall GCSE qualification. No changes to the examination (50%)
