

# Friesland 16-19 Tuition Fund

**Friesland School is in line to receive £3,500 during 2020/21 as part of the Government/ESFA funding agreement, below is our concise statement on how we will allocate this funding:**

- The money is being used to part fund extra hours for our post 16 support person to offer specific support to our Level 2 students. Mainly supporting their return to school, ensuring they are attending both their L2 courses and E&M lessons where appropriate, alongside supporting those students who are accessing the November exams
- This includes making home visits during periods of closure, either due to self-isolation, year group closures or whole school lockdown
- Targeted mental health support is also offered via tutors and on a 1:1 basis
- 1:1 support, tutoring and mentoring is on offer for those students particularly struggling to effectively access either their vocational courses or their E&M lessons.
- We run timetabled English and Maths lessons for those students working towards their grade 4, with small groups taught by subject specialists

**Students have been selected for support on the basis of need, focussing on those following our Level 2 offer in the first instance, then those on our vocational courses, then any other students struggling to catch up since the return to school.**
