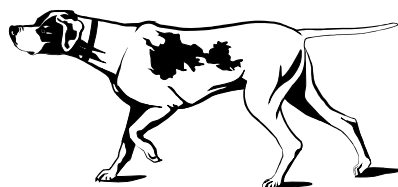

**If entering Regular, the dog must have a MACH title at the time of entry.**

## **CRATING AREA**

The tented crating area is sufficient for all dogs entered. Please note that benches will **NOT** be utilized this year. There will not be space available for un-entered dogs. No private Ex-pens will be allowed in the crating area due to NYC Fire regulations. Soft crates are permitted but not recommended. Dog tents are not permitted. Please do not leave personal items unattended in the crating area as it will be open to the public.

## **MAKE ALL CHECKS payable to Fast Times, Inc**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$80 PER DOG. (Includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee for the first run and \$3.50 for the second run)

- 1. Dogs must have a MACH or a PACH title at the time the entry is received in order for the entry to be valid. To compete in Preferred, the dog must have a PACH title at the time of entry. To compete in Regular, the dog must have a MACH title at the time of entry.**
- 2. There will be a maximum of 2 entries per envelope permitted. Envelopes with more than 2 entries will NOT be accepted.**
- 3. Overall, there will be a limit of 4 entries per owner/handler, but they cannot all be in the same envelope! (Maximum of 2 dogs per envelope)**
- 4. Entries delivered to any other address than the address listed in this premium are invalid and must be returned to the sender.**
- 5. All dogs jumping in the regular class level must jump in their true measured jump height. There is no 24C jump height offered. You cannot enter 2 different jump heights or one Regular class and the other class Preferred. Fix and Go (FNG) is NOT offered at this event.**

**FIRST RECEIVED OPENING DATE: Wednesday, March 6, 2024, at 7:00 AM ET**

This trial is LIMITED to 700 runs excluding the Championship round.

**FIRST RECEIVED CLOSING DATE: Wednesday, April 10, 2024, at 3:00 PM ET**

After which entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules, and in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

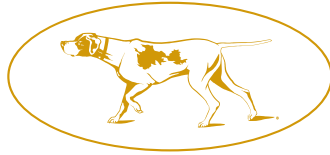

**REFUNDS:** There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date (except for the reasons listed below). No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event organizing committee. No entry will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused from competition by the action of the Trial Committee regardless of the reason for such absences or dismissal. There is a \$5.00 processing fee for ALL refunds. **No refunds will be issued for overpayments of \$10 or less.**

**BITCHES IN SEASON** are not eligible to participate. Entry fees will be refunded minus a \$5.00 processing fee. Written verification from a veterinarian is required. **Notification for refund of bitches in season must be RECEIVED by the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial. ## First Two Rounds (STD & JWW)

1. These two rounds will be scored as AKC qualifying runs. Any Q's achieved will count with AKC towards regular agility titles. Jump heights offered 4"-24". Dogs whose measured height at the withers is 22" and under cannot enter the 24" jump height at this event as there is no 24C" class offered. Dogs may run in their Preferred jump height in both rounds.
2. Judging will begin as early as 7:30 AM. See final confirmation for details.
3. Dogs may not run at a higher height than their true measured height in STD and JWW rounds or in the Championship round.
4. Dogs may run at their Preferred jump height in STD and JWW rounds. For purposes of eligibility and placement for the Championship round, they will be scored and placed within their true jump height group during the re-scoring process. See below for more details.

### Requirements and Scoring for eligibility into the WKC Championship round. STD and JWW runs will determine eligibility:

1. Dogs must Q in one of the first two runs (STD and/or JWW) to be eligible for the Championship round. Elimination (E) or being Absent from either round (STD and/or JWW) will eliminate eligibility for the championship round with a no score.
2. Scoring for eligibility to the Championship round will be the combined actual running time of both runs plus any faults (this includes time faults).
  - a. R, W, T will be assessed 5 points.
  - b. F will be assessed 10 points.
  - c. Course time faults will be 3 points for every full second over course time.
3. After these first two rounds, the data will be re-scored to determine eligibility for the Championship round. Dogs will be placed in order of the lowest combined score within their true AKC jump height.
4. All dogs in the regular level will be required to jump at their AKC regulation jump height based on the shoulder height. Any dog needing measurements must be measured before running. The 4 Paw Safety rule will be in effect.
5. Dogs that ran in the preferred jump height level in the first two rounds must run at their Preferred jump height in the Championship rounds. There is not a separate Preferred Championship round.
6. For purposes of the placement for the Championship round and overall WKC Master Champion, they will be scored and placed within their true jump height group: \*
  - 4" Pref / 8" Reg - all scored together as true jump height 8"
  - 8" Pref / 12" Reg - all scored together as true jump height 12"
  - 12" Pref / 16" Reg - all scored together as true jump height 16"
  - 16" Pref / 20" Reg - all scored together as true jump height 20"
  - 20" Pref / 24" Reg - all scored together as true jump height 24"

7. A maximum of 10 dogs from each jump height will be selected for the Championship round.
8. In each jump height, the top 3 qualifying dogs, regardless of breed, will be chosen for the Championship round. After that, additional dogs will be chosen by individual breed. One of each breed from the remainder of the qualifying dogs in each jump height will be chosen until the limit is reached. One qualifying Canine Partner will be included in the breeds selected to make up the 10 dogs chosen in each jump height.
9. If there are not enough individual breeds to make up the 10 dogs in each jump height, the next dog with the lowest combined score will be included regardless of breed. This means that more than one dog of any breed may be chosen.

### **WKC Championship Round Scoring and Awards:**

1. The Championship course will be a modified Time to Beat style course with a Dog Walk added. The WKC Championship Scoring will be using modified Standard Course rules.
  - a. There will be no Refusals or Runouts (R) called.
  - b. Each Wrong Course (W) will be assessed a 5-point fault.
  - c. Each Failure to Perform (F) will be assessed as a 10-point fault.
  - d. Course Time Faults will be 3 points for every full second over Standard Course Time (SCT).
  - e. Dogs that don't complete the course will be eliminated.
2. Dogs must run in the same jump height in the Championship round that they did in the preliminary classes.
3. Each Dog's Championship Round Score will be calculated using the dog's running time plus any course or time faults (please remember there are no refusals scored in this round but there are time faults). Placements within each true jump height will be determined using the championship round score.
4. The overall Master Championship Round Score will be calculated by taking the Championship Course Yardage for the dog's true jump height divided by the dog's Championship Round Score (which is calculated using the dog's running time plus any course or time faults) for the 1<sup>st</sup> place dogs of each jump height. The highest result will determine the overall WKC Master Champion. For example, if a dog with a Championship Round Score of 39.23 and a Course Yardage of 112 yards then the dog's Master Championship Score would be 2.85.
5. The finals will be televised nationally on FOX on Sunday, May 12<sup>th</sup> at 12:30 PM. As such, Westminster encourages all exhibitors to dress in clean and presentable attire in an effort to present an appropriate image of our sport. No bare feet, please. Our presenting sponsor, Purina/Pro Plan will provide exhibitor shirts.
6. FCI exhibitors must be pre-qualified prior to entering the trial. AKC will review FCI titles to determine if they equate to the corresponding US titles. Entry forms must be submitted by February 19, 2024. Once approved, exhibitors will have to re-enter on the opening date of the Trial.

Westminster Kennel Club is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing on Wednesday, April 10, 2024, at 3:00 PM EST. A maximum of 40 entries will be placed on the club's waitlist.

Entries withdrawn **BEFORE** the trial closes on Wednesday, April 10, 2024, at 6:00 PM EST will receive a full refund (subject to a \$5 processing fee).

Entries withdrawn **AFTER** the trial closes on Wednesday, April 10, 2024, at 6:00 PM EST but **prior to Monday, April 29, 2024, at 3:00 PM EST** will be replaced with an entry from the waitlist **if one is available**. Any withdrawn entry replaced by an entry from the waitlist will receive a refund minus a \$5.00 processing fee.

Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by April 29, 2024, at 3:00 PM EST will receive a refund.

**CLASSES AND DIVISIONS**

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS**

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

**Regular** Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height.

**Preferred** The following jump heights **must** be used in all Preferred Classes.

Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches
Dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	20 inches	16 inches
Dogs over 22 inches	24 inches	20 inches

**Data Entry and Changes to your Information**

Data entry mistakes happen. That is why we ask everyone to READ their preliminary & final confirmation very carefully. For the majority of entries, dog and owner/handler information remains the same. However, if you have a:

- New email address, New Titles, New Handler, New address and phone
- New jump height (including jump height changes from trial to trial.
- For example, dog jumps 20" at one trial, then 24" in the next trial.)

Highlighting **ANY** of these changes on entry forms would be especially helpful so that these changes can be updated in our database. Then, please review your confirmations carefully to ensure that your requested changes have been made.

**\*\*\*TRIAL REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS\*\*\***

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$30.00 will be owed for each returned check. **FAX, TELEPHONE, ONLINE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted on opening day.

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES** will be made as soon as the trial closes or limits are reached. Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS**-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

**CONSULT FINAL CONFIRMATION FOR TIME OF JUDGING.**

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**TRIAL COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

**DOGS** This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners listing number (if the trial-giving club is offering the option of Canine Partners entries. See front page of the premium for that information), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate if the trial-giving club is offering the option of mixed breed entries provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

**DOGS MUST ARRIVE** prior to 8:00 AM, otherwise, they must be available for measuring before their class begins.

## **Agreement**
