- Bathroom, Laundries and Toilets will require sealant application to the entire floor perimeter and where the floor joins baths, tubs, sinks, sanitary fixtures and sanitary alliances to prevent water penetration to concealed spaces.

Please take care when using Hydrokit flexible sealant and use only as required in Wet Area room applications. Whilst the product is flexible, over use, through other areas of the home could restrict laminate floors ability to move with seasonal change and will void the product warranty.

Use expanded foam to close the expansion gap and avoid excessive use of Hydrokit.








Installation Instructions


- · Apply Hydrokit using a caulk gun on a clean, dry, dust-free and grease-free surface; then smooth with a putty knife.
- The Hydrokit should preferably be applied at temperatures between +5°C and +30°C.
- Maximum expansion of 25%.
- · Please ensure all wet area room treatments have an expansion trim installed at all doorway interfaces.

















Wall Base




Door Frame
