In a context of health crisis, French manufacturers are present at the Aero India 2021 exhibition

The French Pavilion coordinated by GIFAS, French Aerospace Industries Association, will **showcase 20 companies** at this international show to be held in Bangalore from February 3 to 5, 2021.

If we add the French companies taking their own stands: Airbus - Dassault Systèmes - Liebherr Aerospace - Lisi Aerospace (ANKIT) - Nicomatic India - MBDA -Stäubli Tec-System), France once again has the strongest foreign representation at the Bangalore Airshow.

It also testifies to French industry's commitment to contribute to the development of India's aerospace and defence industry.

As a reminder, French companies are investing in India to produce and design high-tech aircraft and components. **More than 60 French companies have a presence in the country** (industrial facilities - representative offices).

Their actions are part of the strategic partnership that unites our two countries.
