



GLADD Student Prize Terms & Conditions

Entry

- Current members of the GLADD committee are not eligible to enter.
- Our judging process will be rigorous and fair. The judges are a diverse group and all have experience as writers. All submissions will be randomised and anonymised by one administrator before being sent to the judges. Entries will be scored on their literary merit, writing quality and accuracy. The judges' decision will be final.
- The competition is open to all medical & dental students attending UK universities and Foundation Year doctors, or pre-registration equivalent positions. You do not have to be a GLADD member to enter.
- Entries can be of any length up to a maximum word count of 1000 words (excluding footnotes, references, additional/explanatory material if used).
- The style and tone can be any; for example serious, frivolous, dark, joyful, dangerous or humorous. The substance of your piece should refer to the theme (however loosely).
- Please use Times New Roman size 10 with 1.5 line spacing for the main body.
- If you use references please use Vancouver style.

Prizes

- Winners of monetary prizes will receive these via bank transfer. They will be asked to provide their bank details to the GLADD administrator for this purpose.
- If awarded a prize or commendation current members will be reimbursed the cost of membership for the relevant duration by bank transfer. They will be asked to provide their bank details to the GLADD administrator for this purpose. Reimbursements will take place shortly after winners are announced. Future annual membership payments will be taken as usual according to the original membership start date, regardless of the date of reimbursement.
- New members will receive 6 months free membership and will then be contacted by the administrator to set up a direct debit payment for ongoing membership. New memberships will commence from the date of signing up via the website.
- New members awarded a prize or commendation will have this period of free membership added to their initial 6 months and will be contacted after the total time to set up a direct debit payment for ongoing membership.
- Members may choose to terminate their membership at any time and are welcome to join again in future via the normal sign up process on the website.
