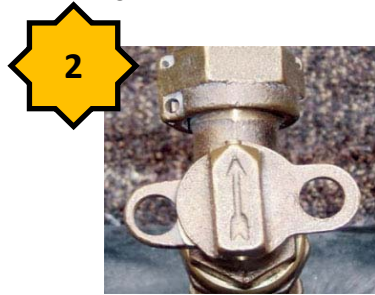




HOW TO SHUT OFF YOUR WATER



1
Locate your meter box. It will be curbside and rectangular or round.



2
There is a single valve in the meter box. To turn the water off, use a wrench to turn the valve one half turn clockwise until the arrow faces away from the meter. Turn the water back on, turn it one half turn back toward the meter.



3
Relieve pressure in the pipes by draining the water already in them. Run hot and cold water from the lowest point in your home.



TOOLS NEEDED:

- Water shut off key or
- Adjustable crescent wrench
- screwdriver



Interior water shut off valves are located under the sinks, and on the side of your toilets. Turn the valves clockwise to shut them off.

Water heater's have shut off valves but you must cut the Power to the water heater before you shut off the valve.

Turn your sprinkler system off at the controller.



5
The irrigation valve box is green and typically located near the exterior shut-off of your home near the water



6
Inside the box is a series of cut-off valves on each end. Either of the valves will shut off the water to your irrigation system.
