A Trail Mix of Volunteering at Great Parks

National Trails Day is celebrated every year on the first Saturday in June as a call to action to the hiking community to give back. This holiday was established by the American Hiking Society in 1993 and was hugely successful with hundreds of organizations participating nationwide. Great Parks celebrates this holiday by inviting community members to join us for a day of volunteering focused on improving, extending, or maintaining our trails. This year we had a small but mighty group of volunteers join our staff for a hot day of hard work out at Woodland Mound's Hedgeapple Trail extension. With the help of volunteers, we were able to remove multiple truckloads of debris they were along the trail extension making it more pleasant to hike. A big thanks to Dan Hart, Trails Specialist, for helping organize this project!





Luckily volunteers have more opportunities to help keep our trails tidy than just one day a year! One of our most popular volunteer opportunities is our Adopt-A-Trail program. For this program, volunteers attend a trail maintenance training and then perform trail checks at a minimum of every two weeks and report major issues to our staff. This is a great role for people who need a volunteer opportunity that is flexible as they can perform their trail checks on their own schedule. We have volunteers at over 25 different sites helping maintain the amazing trail system we have in the big lands!

Dan has also been working on developing a very cool volunteer program that's specifically focused on trail work! Dan started hosting his Trailblazer events just last year and they've already clocked almost 100 volunteer hours. Dan does a tremendous job of using these events to educate volunteers as well as do some amazing work. It's an excellent alternative for volunteers who are on the waiting list for our Adopt-A-Trail program.
