A modernist home in our neighborhood was featured in a story in [Architectural Digest](#).

The home, built in 1971, is owned by architect Eddie Maestri, who founded [Maestri Studio](#), and his husband, Adam Moore. They [used to live in Lakewood](#) but wanted more square footage and a bigger backyard for their twin sons.

They decided on a 5,000-square-foot L-shaped home with high ceilings, white terrazzo floors, verandas and a pool in the backyard. The property backs up to a small lake.

Maestri painted the exterior brick white but kept the roof brown. For the interior design, he drew inspiration from Palm Springs and New Orleans.
