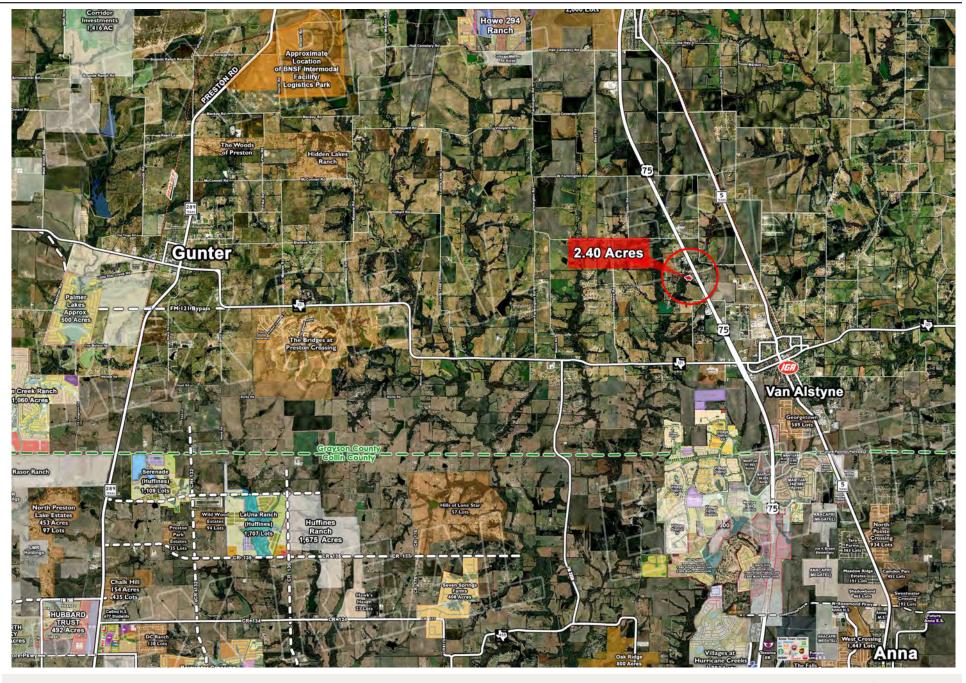

109 Simmons Loop - Located West of US-75, along Simmons Loop in Van Alstyne, TX

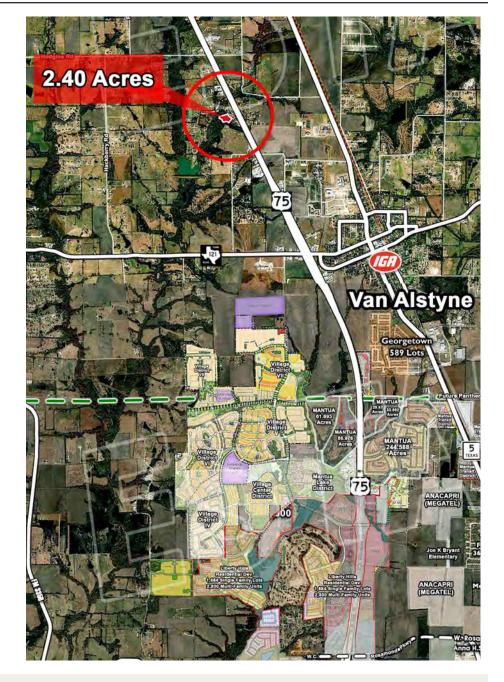


#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

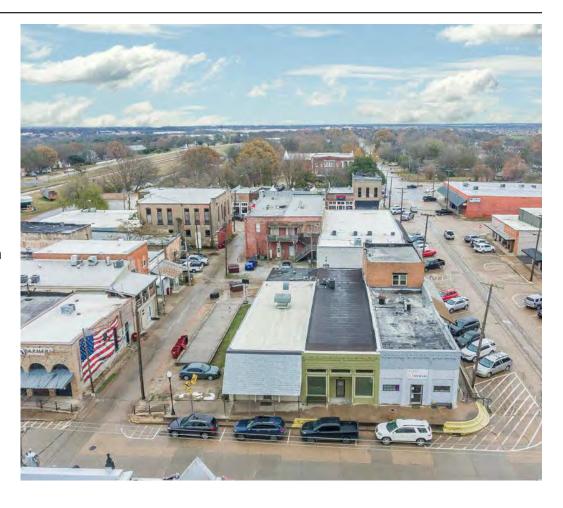


# VAN ALSTYNE HIGHLIGHTS
