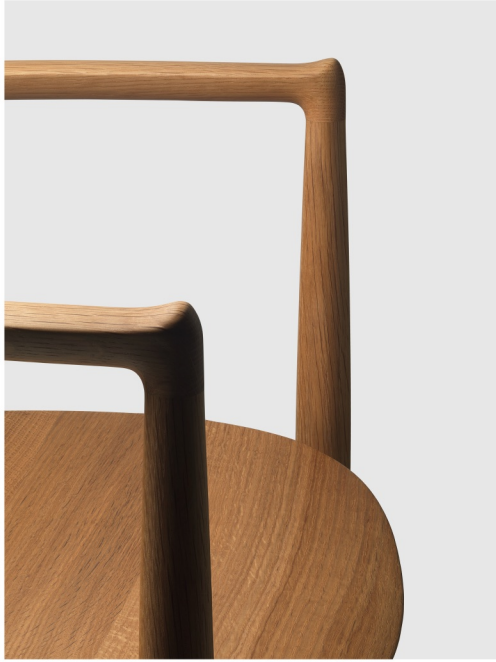

Signature Bentwood Construction With Flowing Grain

The Miau Armchair's defining feature is its backrest and armrests, each crafted from a single piece of bentwood. This seamless structure creates visual lightness while showcasing KOYORI's expertise in solid wood craftsmanship—refined through over 100 years of expertise in woodworking.

Rooted in Generational Mastery

First, creating the mold for bending the parts was essential to making the Miau Armchair ready for production. In addition, moisture control and high-temperature steam bending—techniques passed down through generations—allow the complex curves of the armrest and backrest to be formed with accuracy, defining the chair's character and quality.

Gentle Details With Danish and Feline Inspiration

The soft curves of the Miau Armchair echo the shape of a cat's ears, full of personality and charm. The slope at the armrest tips adds a playful touch, inviting use and highlighting the warmth of the material. These sculptural details draw on the timeless language of Danish classical design — admired for its balance of elegance and everyday usability, something that resonates deeply with Stine's Danish heritage.

Sculpted Comfort With Material Flexibility

The three-dimensionally milled seat and backrest of the wooden seat offer support, naturally contouring the body, while the integrated cushion for the upholstered seat adds softness without breaking the purity of the chair's sculptural form. The frame is available in oak or walnut, with a wide range of upholstery options to suit both residential and contract settings.

A Lasting Chair With a Personal Story

The Miau Armchair is GamFratesi's first all-wood furniture piece, designed in close collaboration with KOYORI's workshop. Crafted from solid wood, it's built to last and age beautifully—bringing warmth and care into everyday life.

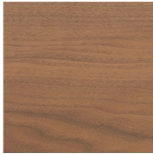

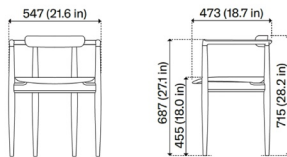

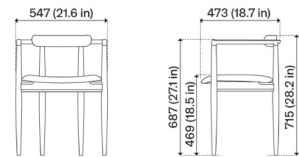
