

Zeversolar Statement to

(REACH) the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals
REGULATION (EC) No 1907/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF
THE COUNCIL

The European Union amended the Chemicals Act and recorded it in the new
REACH regulation at the end of 2006.

Due to this regulation, manufacturers and importers of chemical substances (natural
substance, elements and compounds) can be requested to have the used substances
registered at the European Chemicals Agency, or to pass on information about the used
substances to their customers. Without the registration required by law, sale of the
products is prohibited.

Zeversolar is neither a manufacturer nor an importer of substances or products, but
rather only a downstream user for the purpose of the REACH regulation. Your company
obtains electronic products from us. In chemical law, the electronic components within
there are considered as products. Substance in products must only be registered if these
substances are released as intended upon use of the product. As a rule, this is not the
case with components; therefore, the substances in components do not have to be
registered.

Since no substance should be released from our products under proper use conditions,
the obligations concerning registration and the obligations to provide the purchaser
with a safety data sheet or safety information are not relevant here.

Aside from this, at present only the manufacturers of the electronic components are able
to give clear and precise details about what chemical substances are used in their
products and whether there is a duty of notification

According to our present state of knowledge, however, none of the substance mentioned
in the list of substances of especially high concern are contained in our products in
proportions of over 0,1% by weight

In case Zeversolar receives important information from the manufacture, we will
immediately forward them to all customers without having been asked
