What regulatory agencies set first aid standards?

- The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) enforces workplace regulations based on best practice guidelines (including the ANSI/ISEA first aid standard).
- The International Safety Equipment Association (ISEA) writes the "Minimum Requirements for Workplace First Aid Kits and Supplies" standard.
- The American National Standards Institute (ANSI) oversees the development and use of standards in the U.S.

Clearly marked "ANSI/ISEA required" bars on appropriate packages help users easily identify which supplies must be stocked to maintain compliance with the OSHAenforced ANSI/ISEA³ standard for first aid in foodservice operations.

What are the first aid requirements for restaurants?

According to OSHA regulations, every hospitality and foodservice operation is required to have a first aid kit easily accessible, and it must be stocked with specific supplies.¹

What is the ANSI/ISEA Standard?

- The ANSI/ISEA Z308.1 standard establishes minimum performance requirements for first aid kits and their supplies that are intended for use in various work environments.²
- The standard classifies first aid kits based on the assortment and quantity of first aid supplies intended to deal with most types of injuries and sudden illnesses encountered in the workplace, including major wounds, minor wounds (cuts and abrasions), minor burns, sprains and strains, and eye injuries.
