




## MODEL RB51PL

## **Mobile Laundry Scale**

#### TOOLS REQUIRED:

(2) 7/16 wrenches or sockets







1 person assembly









Set base upside down and insert caster stem into base leg. Insert full-thread hex bolt into each leg hole, and secure with nylon locking nuts facing toward inside of unit. Repeat for remaining casters.

STEP **2** 

Turn base over so wheels are down. Attach handle bar to base by removing pre-installed upper base bolt, threading it through handle bar and re-inserting into original hole in base. Do not completely tighten until bottom bolt has been inserted.



STEP 3

Insert partial-thread hex bolt through bottom hole of handle bar and through base. Secure with nylon lock nut. Tighten all bolts and nuts on handle bar.

# WARNING

- $\cdot$  Never allow anybody to ride in or on cart.
- $\cdot \ \text{Always proceed slowly}.$
- · Be sure wheels roll free and turn easily.
- · Place all loads in center of basket for balance.
- · Maximum capacity per basket: 100 pounds.

Repeat steps 2 and 3 on other side of base to attach second handle bar.



STEP **5** 

Thread the scale's pre-installed bolts through holes in top of base. From the bottom of the base, attach a washer followed by a nut on each of the 4 bolts. Secure with 7/16 wrench.

**NOTE:** It may be necessary to loosen pre-installed nuts on bottom of scale to align the bolts with the holes in base. Be sure to re-tighten nuts if this is done.



STEP **6** 

Place the Poly Tub between the arms of the handles and onto the scale.

**NOTE:** Be sure that handle bars do not rest on sides of Poly Tub. If they do, gently pull handles away from tub until a small gap is created. This will assure that the scale will register properly. If scale needs to be zeroed out, there is a small dial on right side that can be turned until the indicator reads zero.

Your Mobile Laundry Scale is ready for use.
