Scent is an important emotional influencer and pleasant aromas give places, objects, humans or brands a powerful, unique and coherent identity.


The use of fragrance can affect the amount of time a person spends in a store, igniting behaviors such as morale, brand recognition and purchase behavior.



GENERAL PRECAUTIONS

- 1. Read all instructions outlined in this guide before using your SensaMist®.
- 2. When filling or refilling the diffuser please use eye protection and gloves.
- 3. Any spills on surfaces should be cleaned immediately, for more information please see the label of the fragrance oil product.
- 4. If the equipment will not be used for a long period, the unit must be cleaned with alcohol before it is packed away.

HOW TO SET UP THE UNIT



*Includes: Unit, power adapter, user manual, installation kit and spare parts.

PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS

1. SET CURRENT TIME AND DAY:

Set up the hour: Press **SET** and the hour will start flashing. Use the **UP** [,] and **DOWN** [,] arrows to adjust the hour.

Set up the minutes: Press **SET** and the minutes will start flashing. Use the **UP** [\sim] and **DOWN** [\sim] arrows to adjust the minutes.

Set up the Current Day: Press **SET** and the day will start flashing. Use the **UP** [\sim] and **DOWN** [\sim] arrows to adjust the current day of the week.

Press **SET** to accept the time and current day.

Notes:

- 🗙 Indicates flashing/blinks.
- This diffuser uses the 24 hour clock, so 4:00 pm should be programmed as 16:00, etc.
- When programming if no selection is done in 10 seconds, the screen will go to the default screen.

2. PROGRAM AN OPERATIONAL EVENT PERIOD:

The diffuser allows you to program four individual operational event periods. Prior to programming your SensaMist® diffuser, know your preferred operational parameters, (e.g., 8:00 – 16:00, Mon-Fri).

When programming if no selection is done in 10 seconds, the screen will go to default.

2.1. Press MODE to program the time and day the diffuser should begin dispensing fragrance.

Set up the hour: Press **SET** and the hour will start flashing. Use the **UP** [~] and **DOWN** [~] arrows to adjust the hour.

Set up the minutes: Press **SET** and the minutes will start flashing. Use the **UP** $[\sim]$ and **DOWN** $[\sim]$ arrows to adjust the minutes.



Set up the Day(s): Press **SET** and the day(s) will start flashing. Use the **UP** [\sim] and **DOWN** [\sim] arrows to adjust the day(s) of the week.

2.2. Press **MODE** to program the time the diffuser stops working for the day.

Set up the hour: Press **SET** and the hour will start flashing. Use the **UP** [,] and **DOWN** [,] arrows to adjust the hour.

Set up the minutes: Press **SET** and the minutes will start flashing. Use the **UP** $[\]$ and **DOWN** $[\]$ arrows to adjust the minutes.

2.3. Press **MODE** to program the spray duration.

Use the **UP** [,] and **DOWN** [,] arrows to adjust the spray duration from 5 seconds to 300 seconds.

2.4. Press **MODE** to program the spray interval.

Use the **UP** [¬] and **DOWN** [¬] arrows to adjust the "spray inerval/ time between sprays" duration from 5 seconds to 300 seconds.

2.5. Press MODE to program extra events (2 through 4).

If you are only creating one programming setting for this diffuser, you can press **MODE** to skip through Event 2, Event 3, and Event 4. This should bring you back to the first screen which is the Current Time and Day in Step 1.

If you would like to program additional events for different times or days, begin with Step 2.1. and follow along through Step 2.5. for each additional event.



O SAMPLE DEMO: In this example we want to set the unit to be active from 8 am until 10 pm Monday-Friday, however at the weekend we want the unit to be active from 9 am on Saturday through 10 pm on Sunday.

	START	END	DAYS
EVENT 1	08:00	22:00	Mon-Fri
EVENT 2	09:00	23:59	Sat
EVENT 3	00:00	22:00	Sun

Additional Events may not be programmed to intersect operational hours on the same given day. For example, if Event 1 is programmed to work Mon-Fri from 08:00 to 16:30, Event 2 cannot be programmed to work on Fri-Sat from 14:00 to 22:00 because Friday's hours of operation intersect.

DISPLAY KEY

MODE button: Press the button for 10 seconds and it will take the programming to default settings.

- Spray: start time/days (8:00, Mon-Sun)
- Spray: stop time (22:00)
- Spray duration: 60
- Spray interval: 60



	"Display" or [Button]	Display Function	Programming Mode
1.	"WORK" or "PAUSE"	Current State of Dosing Cycle	"WORK" – Will diffuse fragrance. "PAUSE" – Will not diffuse fragrance.
2.	"ON" or "OFF"	Current Event Status	"ON" – Displays that an Event is currently in progress. "OFF" – Displays that an Event is currently in an off period.
3.	[MODE]	Cycles Through Programming	Cycles between current day/time, Work start time, Work end time, Spray duration, Spray interval, and additional Events.
4.	[SET]	Cycles Through Programming Options.	Use the [SET] button to cycle between hours, minutes, and days of the week options.
5.	[UP]	Toggle Up through Programming Options	
6.	[DOWN]	Toggle Down through Programming Options	
7.	"12:27 "	Current Time of Day	Displays the current time of day. The time is displayed as a 24-hour clock, or "military time."
8.	"WED"	Current Day of the Week







FRAGRANCE BOTTLE REPLACEMENT

Ensure device is off before opening the front cover. Wearing protective gloves, open the front cover and remove the oil bottle by gently pulling it towards you. Carefully fill the bottle with a maximum of 180 ml, align the device with the nozzle facing outwards and then gently push the bottle back into the device. Close the front cover and dispose of the gloves safely.

MAINTENANCE & CLEANING

- 1. The SensaMist® must be operated and maintained in accordance with this user manual.
- 2. DO NOT mix the fragrance oil refill with water.
- 3. DO NOT tilt the machine when replacing with fragrance oil.
- 4. Please ensure you tighten the fragrance oil bottle fully when replacing.

Depending on how often the diffuser is used, we recommend that you clean the internal workings every 3-6 months.

- 1. Remove the oil bottle and replace it with a bottle containing industrial alcohol (50 ml).
- 2. Run the diffuser for 5-10 minutes on.

NOTE: Use only in a well-ventilated area.
