MINUTES of a Special Meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Pleasantville Fire District held on April 3, 2025 during a recess in the Annual Meeting of the Pleasantville Volunteer Fire Department in the Meeting Room, Pleasantville Fire Headquarters, 75 Washington Avenue, Pleasantville, New York pursuant to prior notice.

Attending: Commissioners M. Rufino, J.M. Cullen, M. Colmenares, C. Onuma and T. Trudo. Secretary-Treasurer T. Langan. Members of the Chief's Staff and numerous department members also attended.

The Chairman stated that the reason for the meeting was to consider and act upon the nominations for Department Line Officers made at the Annual Meeting of the Pleasantville Volunteer Fire Department held this evening.

The Secretary reported that the Department had nominated the following individuals for office: Assistant Chief Martineau to be Chief of the Department; Chief Scopino to be Assistant Chief, 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant Stephane Zapletal to be 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant and Captain Sean Conway to be 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant.

The Chairman inquired of the Board's approval or disapproval of the nominations.

On a motion by Commissioner Rufino, seconded by Commissioner Colmenares, and unanimously carried, each of the nominees was appointed to the office for which he had been nominated, in each case until his respective successor is nominated, appointed, installed and sworn into office.

Badges were presented as follows: Cori Martineau presented the Chief's badge to her husband, Chief Martineau, at his request. Luke Scopino presented the Assistant Chief's badge to his father, Assistant Chief Scopino. Ex-Chief Roger Lemcke presented the First Lieutenant's badge to First Lieutenant Zapletal, and Ex-Commissioner John Thys presented the Second Lieutenant's badge to Second Lieutenant Sean Conway.

The Secretary then administered the following Oath of Office to the Department Line Officers, as follows:

The Chairman thanked all present for coming to the meeting.
