3 Setting The Trap





a. Position trap so that the indentation made in step 2e is centered between the trap's jou. Intert jave into tunnel so that tunnel is sperpondicular to trap?

S. Hop straight down one out of yellow foot petald. Be careful not to cover slot in foot potal.

C. Work foot petald down until higger post flow's through slot.

d. Use foot or finger to press trigger post flow's with foot petal. The trap is now set.

TIP 1: If trop will not set, check that indentation made in Step 2e is at certed depth;

TIP 2: If rop will not set, check that indentation made in Step 2e is at certed depth;

TIP 2: If rop will not set after several attempts more to a new location and repeat
steps 2 & 3.

If trop has not triggered after 24 to 48 hours, trop may be moved to a new location. Place fool lightly on potel and see downlyfulks to press the safety release button. Trop will spring upwards when latch is released. Remove trop part move to another order numbers, respecting steps 2 and 3 to reset trop.
